The clinic accepts Medicaid and most insurance plans.

Two locations have been determined as “test-to-stay” sites for our district students and staff:

- Downing Pediatrics
- Carden Park Clinic

The program is not required, it is an opt-in situation for parents who want to get their children tested at no cost. A student must be tested every other day in the first seven (7) days of exposure. The testing at the above locations will occur on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 7am-8:15 am. Testing is also offered at Urgent Care locations, CVS, Walgreens or contact your

		primary care physician. The “test-to-stay” program allows students to stay in school and participate in extracurricular activities as long as the criteria are met.
