

Project CHILD FIND is a free referral service and public awareness campaign to assist in the identification of unserved/underserved youth with a delay or disability from birth through twenty-one years of age. In addition, Project CHILD FIND develops and distributes information to the public about early intervention services and special education programs throughout New Jersey. Project CHILD FIND's comprehensive efforts include:

1. Assisting families of infants and toddlers, birth through two, concerned about their child's development: Families concerned about their infant or toddler's development can contact an Early Intervention Service Coordinator 888-653-4463.
2. Assisting families of children, three through twenty-one concerned about their child's development by directing requests to their local school district. If you are concerned about your child and are uncertain about what you should do, please call the Mount Arlington Public School District Child Study Team at 973-398-4400.
