Propel Resident Teachers earn their Pennsylvania teaching certification while receiving support and guidance from Propel Schools Residency Staff and Point Park University.

Program Benefits

- Fully funded American Board for Certification Teacher Excellence (ABCTE) track
- Fully funded Point Park University tuition
- \$2,000 monthly stipend to help cover living expenses plus health insurance during the first residency year
- Year-long professional development and mentorship with an experienced Propel educator and the PTRP team
- Three years of full-time employment with Propel Schools upon successful completion of the residency year
- Opportunity to have a significant impact on the lives of scholars

Program Eligibility

- Holds a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university
- Pennsylvania Department of Education clearances Act 34 (Criminal), Act 151 (Child Abuse), Act 114 (FBI Criminal History) and negative TB test
- Is not currently enrolled in, nor has completed, a teacher preparation or certification program
- 2+ years experience working with children in an urban setting preferred
