

## Statement of Faith

Fellowship Christian School was established in 1986 to assist Christian families in nurturing their children academically, spiritually, physically and socially. As one of the school's foundational standards, the STATEMENT OF FAITH serves to formally acknowledge the theological basis of its educational philosophy and practices.

As a prerequisite for admission to FCS, we require that at least one parent agrees with and personally

acknowledges this same doctrinal standard for his/her life and can express a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. In addition, it is expected that families seeking enrollment at FCS regularly attend a local church, which upholds the evangelical tradition expressed in the faith statement below.
