AP and CE CREDITS

Concurrent Enrollment (CE)

College Class @ SHS

If you get a passing grade then you receive college credit. The grade goes on both your high school and college transcripts

Pay a one-time \$30.00 WSU admission fee then \$5 per credit (\$15 total for one semester class)

You MUST have a 3.0 cumulative GPA to take General Education classes

Withdrawing early gives you a "W" on your college transcript and may affect your ability to get financial aid

Advanced Placement (AP)

If you pass the AP test at the end of the year with a score of 3 or above you receive college credits on your transcript.

Pay \$96 for each test

Credits transfer to universities across the nation. The most competitive universities prefer AP scores over CE grades.



Certificate of Completion

- ▶ Certificate from Weber State University stating all General Education Requirements are fulfilled –
- ▶ Present this to any State University or College and General Education Requirements are waived, even if they are different.
(Additional prerequisites may be required depending on degree)
- ▶ Approximately 37 college credits from both AP and CE Classes – you can complete the requirements at SHS
- ▶ Note: An Associates Degree at a university requires 60 credits.

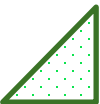




