Good News: The Board recognized four seniors at Andover High School who have been named National Merit Semifinalists for their outstanding performance on the PSAT/NMSQT exam as juniors. They are Alexis Brown, Corbin Hoppas, Danton Nguyen and Jeremiah Rather. They will now move on to the next round of competition.

Special education: April Hilyard, director of the Butler County Special Education Interlocal, and Shelley Jonas, assistant director, presented about the [state of the interlocal](#) and special education in general in Kansas.

Website update: Terry Rombeck, director of communication, presented an update on plans to migrate the district's website to a new provider in summer 2023.

Mechanical systems: Board members approved a one-year contract for \$136,552 with Building Controls & Services for preventative maintenance services for district boilers, chillers and commercial domestic hot water systems to ensure the systems operate effectively, reliably and efficiently.

Superintendent's report: Superintendent Brett White told the Board that Cottonwood Elementary would be celebrating its National Blue Ribbon School designation the week of Oct. 24-28. Cottonwood will be recognized at a national conference and awards banquet Nov. 2-4 in Washington, D.C.
