## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Provides medical assessment and treatment for all staff and students and also offers medical emergency treatment for all school community (drivers, security, nannies, cafeteria staff, parents, cleaner, and daily workers)
- 2. Controls Immunization Records and contributes to tuberculosis screening and immunization, such as flu vaccines, hepatitis, typhoid, etc. for students, staff, and families
- 3. Collaborates with parents to arrange daily and or emergency medications for students
- 4. Provides assessment to students for vision, hearing, and scoliosis and notifies staff and parents if there is any medical concern
- 5. Provides first aid supplies and support for special events and standby 24 hours for the overnight field trip



- 6. Consults and collaborates with parents, teachers, school administrators, and community health or social service agencies to address student health problems and plan health services
- 7. Provides medical assistance standby for after school activities, collaborates with campus supervisor, community liaison, and coaches
- 8. Provides medical supervision and conducts "Contact Tracing" process during COVID-19 situation
- 9. Keeps Inventory of nursing supplies and equipment
- 10. Embraces the JIS Learning Dispositions of Resilience, Resourcefulness, Relating well with others, and Reflecting
- 11. Performs other related duties and assuming other responsibilities as assigned by the Health Officer, including, and not limited to participation in class/School's activities or events, attendance of workshops organized by JIS
