<p>Freshman Seminar: Freshmen Seminar is a semester course for ninth graders that is designed to help students maximize their time at Randolph High School. The course awards 2.5 of the 5 required credits for 21st Century Life and Careers needed toward graduation. Freshmen identify and develop career and college readiness skills through participating in both individual and group activities that help to explore interests and abilities. They also meet with Tomorrow's Leaders who help guide them through the transition from middle school to high school and expose them to the available resources at the high school. The course culminates in an experiential learning project where students identify a community need and design a plan to address that need.
