



Honors Recognition

- **Graduation with Citizenship Honors** (*PEACOCK BRAID*) Students who complete grades 9-12 without receiving any unsatisfactory citizenship marks (U's) are eligible to graduate with Citizenship Honors
- **Graduation with Academic Honors** (*SILVER BRAID*)Meet graduation requirements and have a cumulative GPA of 3.60-3.799 through 3rd term.
- Graduation with High Academic Honors (GOLD BRAID) Meet graduation requirements and have a cumulative GPA of 3.80-3.999 through 3rd term.
- **Graduation with Academic Distinction** (*WHITE BRAID*)Meet Graduation Requirements and have a Cumulative GPA of 4.0 through 3rd Term.
- ***To graduate with Distinction, High Honors, or Honors, students must have taken at least (5) Honors, AP or Core CE classes (core CE is Math, English, Science, Social Studies or World Language)

What is the Certificate of Completion?



- A Certificate from Weber State University stating all General Education Requirements are fulfilled
- The COC can presented to any State University or College and their GE requirements are waived, even if they are different.
- Approximately 37 college credits from both AP and CE classes

Benefits of the COC

For Example:

- A Student Attending Utah State University that has earned the Weber COC
 - Waives a year and a half of college
 - Saves students near \$30,000 in tuition, fees, books and housing costs.
 - Helps prepare students for the rigors of college academics
 - Waives difficult "Freshman Weed-out" classes.
 - Students graduate from college one and a half years earlier, entering the workforce sooner, with thousands in salary gained.

Students can earn all or part of the COC. Classes in a partially completed COC will most likely transfer, but will be subject to review.

Students that receive The Weber State General Education Certificate of Completion, can present it to any State of Utah college or university and have all GE classes waived at that school.

Students must pass all AP exams with a 3,4 or 5 and submit their scores to Weber State. World Language exams must be passed with a 4 or 5 For CE classes, no grade lower than a C will be accepted for COC credit.

BYU will accept the credits in the COC as a whole, but will add requirements.


