- Reading Data: Shared results from mid-year Acadience with clarification on the meaning of blue and green status.
- Review LT budget status: On track and will most likely have a 10% carryover
- Discussion about proposed gas station on 200 N
 - Public Hearing: [Kaysville City Planning Commission will meet to vote on a proposed plat subdivision at 2368 W 200 N and proposed changes to signage regulations. Thursday, Jan 26, 7:00](#)
 - Parkers presented a video of traffic concerns
 - What can the school do? Currently we have meetings with the city manager. The land is currently zoned commercial and has been for 5 years. The interchange location was added 2 years ago, according to Mr. Tate. Planning commission will review the request by the buyer to allow larger signage. This is not something the school gets involved in, but neighborhoods can share their concerns.
 - Another traffic study will need to be done.
 - Crossing guards: The community knows there is a crosswalk available.
 - School Personnel are trying to help parents follow pick up and drop off procedures. We care very much about student safety.
 - It was shared that the city could still put in a city code before the station can obtain an alcohol license.
 - District has made it clear that we want a crossing guard closer to the school.
 - Starting next year – Kaysville told one parent that they would move the crossing guard from Wellington to Bonneville (per police chief)
 - A sound barrier request was brought up. Shaunna Burbrige checked on this. A sound study would have to be done and it is a “high bar to meet.”
