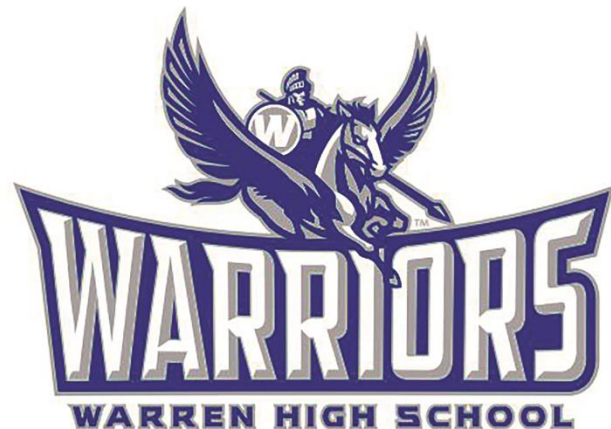
Presenting the 2022 Class
