# Honors Recognition

- **Graduation with Citizenship Honors** (*PEACOCK BRAID*) Students who complete grades 9-12 without receiving any unsatisfactory citizenship marks (U's) are eligible to graduate with Citizenship Honors
- **Graduation with Academic Honors** (*SILVER BRAID*) Meet graduation requirements and have a cumulative GPA of 3.60-3.799 through 3rd term.
- **Graduation with High Academic Honors** (*GOLD BRAID*) Meet graduation requirements and have a cumulative GPA of 3.80-3.999 through 3rd term.
- **Graduation with Academic Distinction** (*WHITE BRAID*) Meet Graduation Requirements and have a Cumulative GPA of 4.0 through 3rd Term.
- \*\*\*To graduate with Distinction, High Honors, or Honors, students must have taken at least (5) Honors, AP or Core CE classes (core CE is Math, English, Science, Social Studies or World Language)

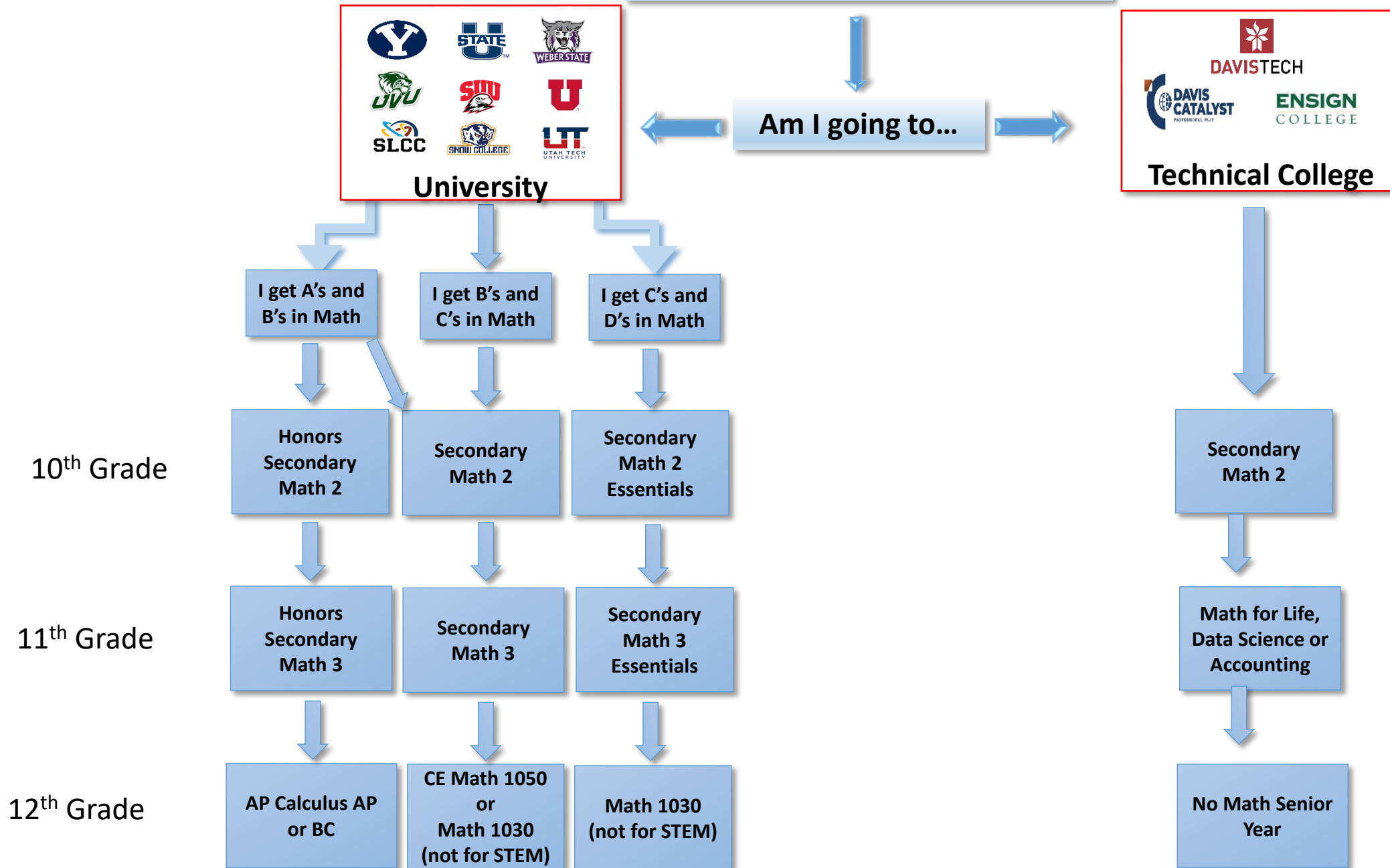

- **Complete the online application before the deadline next year**



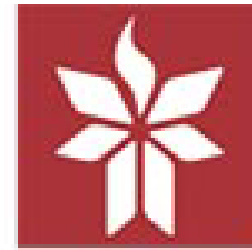
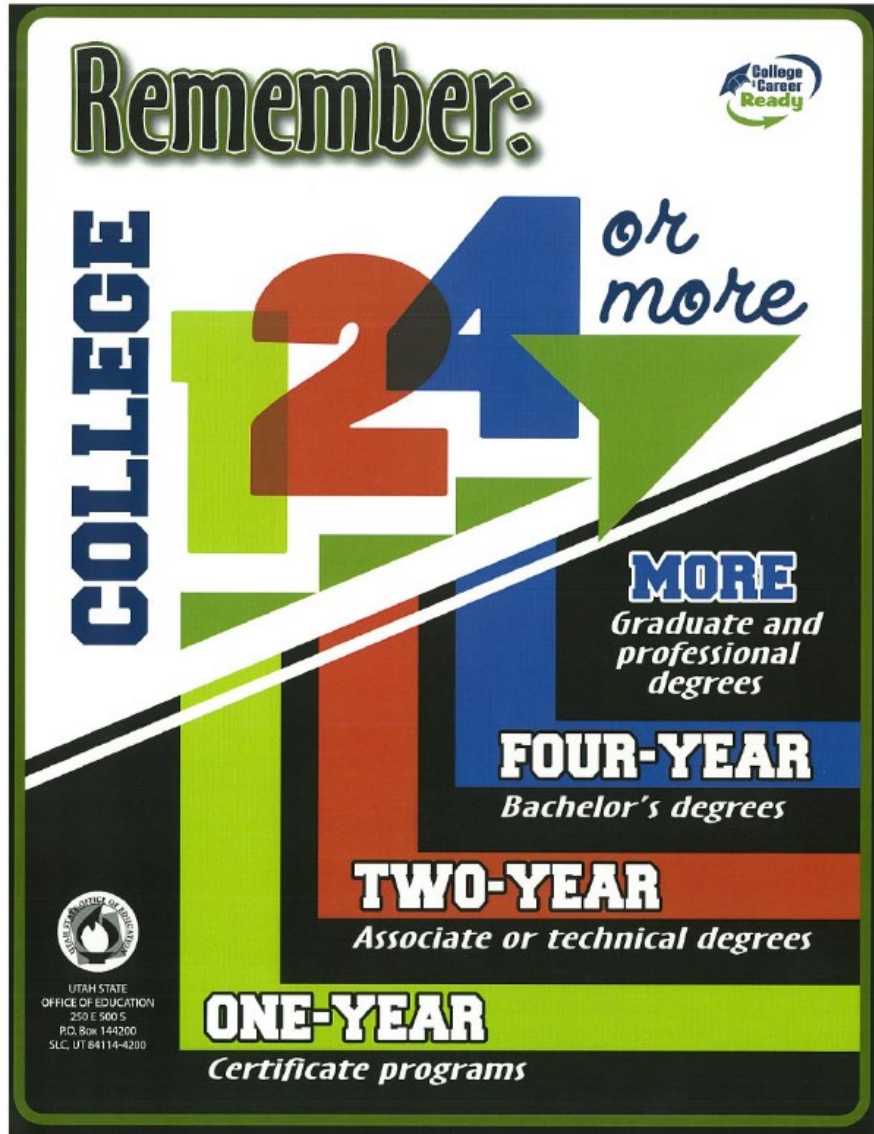
