

SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
Board of Trustees of Challis Joint School District 181
January 6, 2021

The special meeting of the Board of Trustees of Challis Joint School District No. 181 was held at Challis Idaho at the Challis Elementary School Board room at 3:00 p.m. on the 6th day of January 2021 as provided in Sections 33-510 and 74-206 et seq Idaho code.

High School Athletics Plan, Stage 2: Mrs. Zollinger and Superintendent Rembelski discussed how the high school gym was measured off for the two family members to attend events for social distancing according to the Governor Little's updated plan. Trish Farr moved to approve Governor Little's updated plan for two family member per student per event. Jim Chamberlain seconded the motion. Vote 5-0 Motion carries.
