

SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
Board of Trustees of Challis Joint School District 181
March 12, 2018

The special meeting of the Board of Trustees of Challis Joint School District No. 181 was held at Challis Idaho at the Challis Middle School Board room at 12:00 p.m. on the 12th day of March, 2018 as provided in Sections 33-510 and 74-206 et seq Idaho code.

The meeting was called to order at 12:03 p.m. Board members in attendance were Brett Plummer, Jim Chamberlain, Trish Farr and Terri Stillwaugh. Also in attendance were Superintendent Peter McPherson, Principal Russ Bradshaw and Clerk Kim Williams. Audience members were Student 18-01, Student 18-01' parents, Aletia Straub Workman, Annie Lloyd, Katena Swank and Brett Walther attended the meeting by phone.

Executive Session: Trish Farr moved to go into Executive Session as per Idaho Code 74-206 paragraph I subsection b) at 12:30 p.m. Jim Chamberlain seconded the motion.

Trish Farr moved to return to regular session at 12:43p.m. Terri Stillwaugh seconded the motion. Vote 4-0 Motion carries.

Action:

A. Student Discipline: Terri Stillwaugh moved to expel Student 18-01 from the Challis Joint School District 181 from today's date of March 12th to the end of the spring semester of 2018. Such motion is based upon the judgment of the Board of Trustees that Student 18-01 has:

1. Engaged in conduct in violation of the District's Student Discipline Policies, including but not necessarily limited to policies prohibiting threats of physical injury, harassment and cyber-harassment of fellow students.
 2. Engaged in conduct such that the Board has determined the student's presence at school is detrimental to the health, welfare, and safety of the District's pupils.
 3. Engaged in conduct such that the Board has determined the student to be disruptive of the instructional effectiveness of the school.
 4. Engaged in conduct such that the Board has determined the student to be disruptive of the school discipline.
 5. Engaged in conduct such that the Board has determined the student to be incorrigible.
- Prior to the commencement of the 2018-2019 school year, Student 18-01 or the family of Student 18-01 shall be responsible for contacting the District to schedule a Board

Reinstatement Hearing, to allow the Board to consider reinstatement as well as to consider what conditions, if any, the Board will impose if reinstatement is permitted. During the period of expulsion, the student shall not be present upon any District property or at any District activity, regardless of location, absent pre-authorization of the District Administration. Prior to the reinstatement hearing, if the student is receiving any services and/or contact with justice or probation department, paperwork shall be entered into to allow for the exchange of this information only to the extent that such impacts upon the student' education, for the Board's consideration at the time of the reinstatement hearing. During the reinstatement hearing the student and the parent/legal guardian of the student shall be prepared to discuss the activities of the student during the period of expulsion, as well as what actions have been taken to assure that this conduct and violation of District policies will not occur in the future should re-enrollment be permitted. And for the SPED department to be in contact with Student 18-01 parents to continue with school work according to the IEP. Jim Chamberlain seconded the motion. Vote 4-0 Motion carries.

Trish Farr moved to adjourn the meeting at 12:49 p.m. Jim Chamberlain seconded the motion. Vote 4-0
