Services include:

Medicaid

You and your family may qualify for free or low cost health insurance through KY Medicaid. This provides health insurance to low income families, children, adults, pregnant women, the elderly, and those with disabilities. Medicaid health insurance includes dental and vision.

Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)

Families may be eligible for this service as it provides low income families with monthly income if one of both parents are deceased, missing, or disabled. Children must be under 18 years of age, unless in school, then they must be 21 or younger.

Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (K-TAP)

K-TAP is a money assistance program that provides financial and medical assistance to needy dependent children in KY and the parents, relatives, with whom the children are living. It also helps families find jobs or get job training. K-TAP can only be received for 60-months (5 years) in a lifetime.

Emergency Bill Payment Assistance

The Cabinet for Health and Family Services has an emergency assistance program that may be able to help families. If you need to apply, they can call their local DCBS office.

\$6 each way up to 10 miles. Trips over 10 miles are \$1.50 per mile. Services available in Breckinridge, Grayson, LaRue, Marion and Nelson counties and limited services offered in Washington, Edmonson and Hart counties. Provides services including doctor's offices, physical therapy, nutrition centers, grocery stores, pharmacies, senior centers and more. CKCATS can also ensure reliable transportation to and from places of employment, job training sites and educational programs. Passengers must reserve a ride in advance no later than 3 p.m. of the day before departure.

Breckinridge, Grayson, LaRue, Marion and Nelson Counties and for the Bluegrass Ultra-Service (BUS) Brokerage Services in Washington County. Clients must call the transportation broker in their area at least three (3) days in advance of service and request CKCATS as the transportation provider. Benefits can only be used by clients that do not have a working vehicle in the household or can verify in writing that they are not able to use a household vehicle.

Senior Transportation

Monday – Friday: 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

General transit, senior center routes, grocery days, medical appointments and more. Passengers, age 60 and older, may enroll in our Senior Transportation Program. A donation in the amount of \$1 per trip is suggested. Trips after 2 p.m. will be charged the general public transportation fare.

Grocery days are offered to seniors once a week, departing from the senior center or pre-arranged pick-up location in the following counties:

LaRue and Washington County – Wednesday

Breckinridge and Nelson County – Thursday

Grayson and Marion County – Friday

**There is a limit of 5 bags per person.*

Veteran Transportation

Veterans that do not qualify for Senior Transportation may book transportation directly with CKCATS and pay a reduced rate of \$1 per mile. Transportation is available in Breckinridge, Edmonson, Grayson, Hart, LaRue, Marion and Nelson counties. A Veteran ID or discharge paper is required on first trip.

Free for Veterans enrolled in Senior Transportation up to 15 miles within the originating county. All other trips are \$1 per mile.
