Position Summary

The counselor is a valuable part of the St. Paul's teaching team. They are responsible for all aspects of toddler through kindergarten counseling and social emotional programming. They work closely with the teachers, administration, parents, and students.

Major tasks & duties

- Provide counseling and resources to students, teachers, and parents as needed.
- Identify, build, and implement age-appropriate social and emotional support programs across grade levels.
- Provide response to students needing assistance regulating.
- Communicate clearly and efficiently with colleagues and parents both in writing and face to face as needed.
- Be available at parent/teacher conferences and to meet with parents as needed.
- Partner with outside organizations to enhance social emotional education and student support.
- Assess students and make appropriate referrals to outside counselors and organizations.
- Teach occasional chapel lessons; be an active participant and role model during all chapels.
- Provide trainings to faculty and parents in Mandated Reporting as well as other social emotional needs.
- Order and maintain appropriate supplies and materials and work within provided budget.
- Work collaboratively to achieve the mission of the school.
- Set an example of intellectual curiosity, critical thinking, life-skills, self-motivation, and self-discipline.
- Model competence, personal responsibility, and respect for others in every aspect of the job.
- Act as an ambassador for the school by attending school-wide events and supporting the school community outside of the classroom at special events, sporting events, or in other venues.

Minimum qualifications

- Licensed Counselor, Master's Degree in related field (clinical designation preferred).
