Preschool News

During the month of February, preschoolers will be diving deep into the world of construction. We will be discussing all different things revolving around construction from the workers to the simple machines involved. We will explore measurement and different shapes. We will be focusing on the letters P–S as well. We are excited to do some experiments with simple machines to test our knowledge of ramps and the cause and effect that they have on motion. We also will be working on sequencing events as well as comparing fictional and nonfictional texts.

We have been working really hard on learning our letters to be better prepared for Kindergarten. At this point in the year, we have a goal that our students know 50% or more of their uppercase and lowercase letters. Currently, 38 out of the 70 preschoolers know at least 50% of their uppercase letters and 28 out of 70 of our preschoolers know at least 50% of their lowercase letters. If your child is still struggling with identifying their letters, you can have them use <u>www.starfall.com</u> or practice our phonics dance daily.
