Current LBUSD Students: Update ParentVUE

1. Go to lbschools.net
2. Click on Parent Tab
3. Click on ParentVUE support

Questions and Answers

Q. How do I sign up for a ParentVUE account?

A.

You will need an activation key to create your account. Go to the front office at your child's school and present a photo ID to have an activation letter printed. Enter the first and last name and activation key as printed on the letter (if your name is misspelled in the letter or it has changed, let the office secretary or assistant know right away).

Q. My activation key is not working.

Q. I forgot my password.

Q. I can't see all my children in my account. How do I add more children?

Q. I am unable to make all the changes I need in Student Information such as phone numbers, emergency contacts, email addresses, etc.

Changes MUST be made by February 9, 2023

PATHWAY DESCRIPTION

The Applied Technology Magnet at Lakewood High School is digital! Students who are interested in technology should choose ATM at Lakewood. The ATM program allows students to learn how people interact with technology and create projects that illustrate that connection. Students can build a computer, program an arduino, code a Vex robot, create a product and simulate it using 3D printers or laser cutters. ATM's focus is on "Informatics", the practice of living, learning, playing and creating in tomorrow's digital world. ATM offers students the opportunity to receive college credits while attending high school or concurrently enroll at Long Beach City College. Students who graduate from ATM are ready to participate in today's digital world and find the solutions for tomorrow's challenges.

ENTRANCE CRITERIA

No minimum criteria.
Students with a minimum GPA of 3.0 may apply as **ATM Knights**. These students will be enrolled in Accelerated Math and English courses.

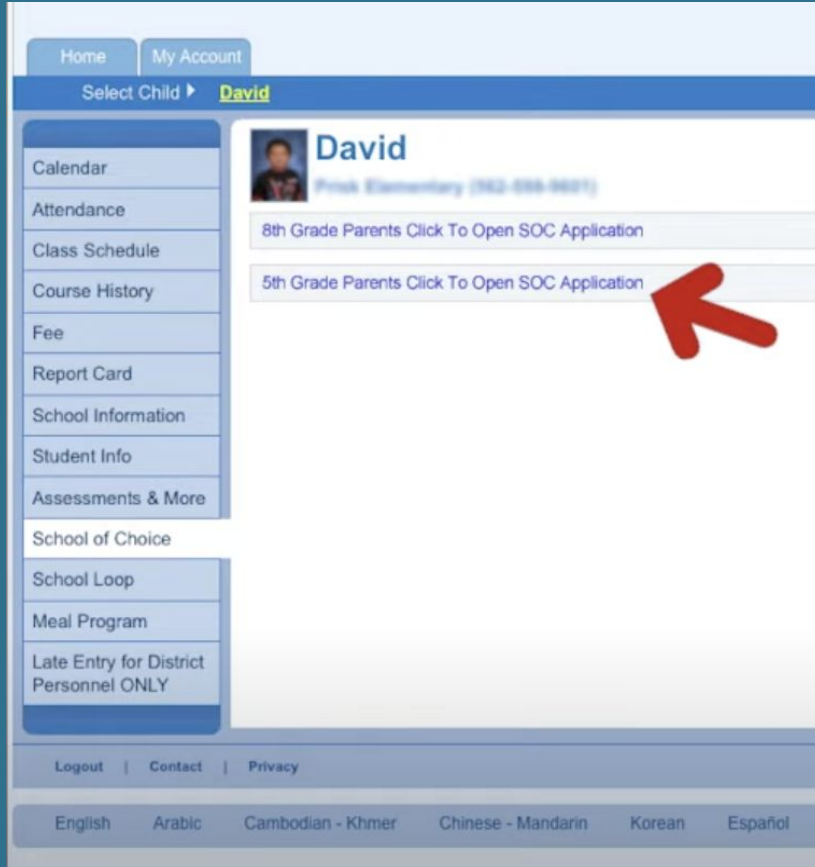

Application Process

Parents access the application from ParentVUE

Click on School of Choice Tab

Step 1: Choose a program at your HSOR (high school of residence)

Step 2: Select up to 3 additional programs and rank your preferences

Step 3: Certify

A “How to Complete the HS Choice Application Video” will be posted on the HS Choice Website in January.

#LetsEngage

High School Choice Limitations

1. Students are given residential priority ONLY when they select a program at the school of residence as their FIRST CHOICE.
2. Students who do NOT complete an application are not automatically placed at their high school of residence.
3. Priority placement is NOT given to a middle school that feeds into a high school.
4. Transportation is not provided to any School of Choice
5. Thematic high schools are not considered residential schools
(even if you live across the street)

(Education Code Section 35160.5)

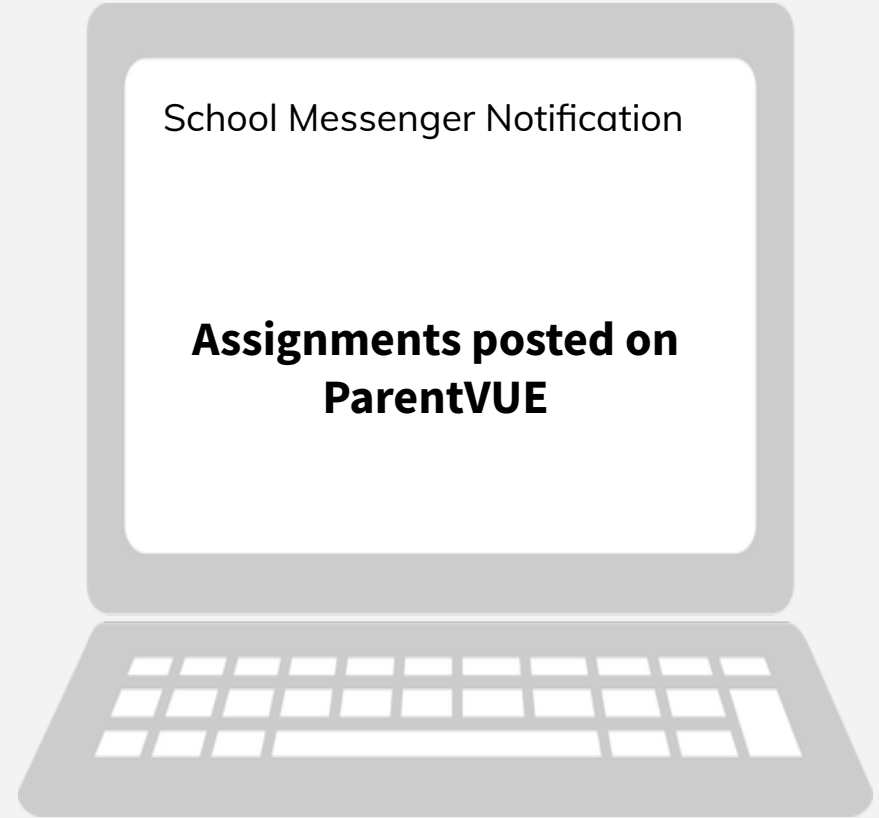
