Marian Catholic defense vs. St Viator

Marian Catholic dropped a 45-14 East Suburban Catholic Conference game to St Viator Friday night at Dave Mattio Field.

St Viator 45, Marian Catholic 14: Ki-Jana Crawford had 92 yards on eight catches, including a 41-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Patrick Schmidt, but the Spartans (2-6, 0-5) lost their sixth straight game. Crawford also had an interception.

St Viator quarterback Bobby Calmeyn was 22-of-39 passing for 263 yards and five touchdowns for the Lions (5-3, 2-3) in the East Suburban Catholic Conference game. Matthew Darling caught three touchdown passes.

Marians' Dillon Burns had 64 yards on 14 carries and scored on an 8-yard run late in the second quarter to put Marian on the board after the Lions took a 21-0 lead.

Crawford intercepted Calmeyn on the ensuing possession to put Marian back in business near midfield. But a pair of holding penalties prompted the Spartans to punt the ball away, enabling Lions to close the half with a field goal and a 24-7 lead.

Schmidt was 14-of-26 passing for 122 yards. Marian kicker Chris Taborn made good on both of his PAT attempts, remaining perfect for the season.
