*Students must earn 2 seals, one must be a state seal*

### State Seals - You must select at least one State Seal

OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal	Meet the requirements and criteria established for the readiness seal, including demonstration of work-readiness and professional competencies. For those students with jobs.
Industry-Recognized Credential Seal	Earn a 12-point approved industry-recognized credential or group of credentials totaling 12 points in a single career field. (JVS Only)
College-Ready Seal	Earn remediation-free scores on the ACT or SAT. As of 2/2021 ACT-Eng 22, Math 22. SAT EBRW 480, Math 530
Military Enlistment Seal	Provide evidence that a student has enlisted in a branch of the U.S. Armed Forces; or Participate in an approved JROTC program.
Citizenship Seal	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Earn a score of proficient(3) or higher on both the American history and American government end-of course exams; And/Or earn a grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in American history and American government</li> <li>2. Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exams; or</li> <li>3. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in appropriate classes taken through the College Credit Plus program.</li> </ol>
Science Seal	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Earn a score of proficient or higher on the biology end-of-course exam; And/Or earn a grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an advanced science.</li> <li>2. Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exams; or</li> <li>3. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an appropriate class taken through the College Credit Plus program.</li> </ol>
Honors Diploma Seal	<p>Earn one of six Honors Diplomas outlined below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Academic Honors Diploma;</li> <li>2. International Baccalaureate Honors Diploma;</li> <li>3. Career-Tech Honors Diploma;</li> <li>4. STEM Honors Diploma;</li> <li>5. Arts Honors Diploma;</li> <li>6. Social Science and Civic Engagement Honors Diploma</li> </ol>

Seal of Biliteracy	Meet the requirements and criteria, including proficiency requirements on assessments in a world language and English. See ODE for more information.
Technology Seal	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on an appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exam;</li> <li>2. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an appropriate class taken through the College Credit Plus program; or</li> <li>3. Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in 1 full credit Technology class or 2 half credit Technology courses offered through the district or school.</li> </ol>

**Local Seals - May select one**

Community Service Seal	Complete 50 hours of community service. See your counselor for an application.
Fine and Performing Arts Seal	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Earn a total of two fine arts credits with a B or higher, or</li> <li>2. For programs outside of Steele, see your counselor for an application.</li> </ol>
Student Engagement Seal	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Attend ten (10) Marion L. Steele High School sponsored home events (games, plays, or concerts). In order for attendance to be verified, the student must sign in with the appropriate school official,</li> <li>2. Complete one (1) full season of a Marion L. Steele High School sponsored sport. Season completion is verified by the Marion L. Steele High School Athletic Director; or</li> <li>3. Complete one (1) full year of active participation in a board-approved club. Club participation will be verified by the club advisor.</li> <li>4. Complete a total of (10) pledge recitals.</li> <li>5. Complete 3 credits of SNL or Med Tech along with active participation in the program. Teacher will confirm the completion of the seal.</li> </ol>
