

# College Admissions Tests

2022-2023

- Many 4 year colleges and universities require either the SAT or ACT for admission. There are a growing number, however, that are no longer requiring admissions tests or have become “test-optional”. Review test requirements by visiting the individual websites of the colleges and universities you are considering. [www.fairtest.org](http://www.fairtest.org) is also a good resource to get information on test-optional schools.
- Many students choose to take the SAT and/or ACT more than once to get the score they want for college applications. Consequently, students should test for the first time in the spring of their 11th grade year. This allows time to retake the exam again in the fall of 12th grade before score reports are needed for college applications.
- **All Juniors will take the SAT at school in March.** The State of Indiana will pay the test fee. Those students can choose to sign up and test at another time also, but all Juniors must take the SAT School Day test.
- Keep in mind that some colleges/universities require that scores be sent directly from SAT or ACT. Students can choose to do that for free at the time they register for the test. Students can also do it later, but there will be a fee. Be sure to check the policies of the colleges and universities you are considering.
- To determine the location of the test, select the test date within your registration portal and the website will generate the list of locations nearest to your mailing address.

## SAT:

- Register at: [www.sat.org/register](http://www.sat.org/register)
- Cost: \$60
  - Fee waivers for those who qualify have been automatically applied to College Board accounts and can be redeemed at the time of registration. If you think you qualify but do not see the waiver on your account, see your school counselor.

- Register at: [www.act.org](http://www.act.org)
- The writing portion is optional. Most colleges/universities do not require it, but some do. Make sure to check the testing requirements of your prospective schools.
- Cost: \$63 (no writing), \$88 (with writing)
  - Fee waivers are available to those who qualify. See your school counselor.
