Kristyn was a three sport athlete and team captain in volleyball, basketball and softball. She was a four year letter winner in both volleyball and softball, and two year letter winner in basketball. She received multiple All-Conference, All-State accolades in both volleyball and softball. In 1999 Kristyn was awarded Chaska's Female Athlete of the Year. Upon graduation, she played Division I volleyball for Fordham University. Kristyn was named Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the week in 2001 at Fordham University. In 2021 she was named to the Fordham 25 year Anniversary Team. She continues to hold onto the record for most assists in a 3 and 5 set match, while placing 5th in all setter related categories in the Fordham University database.

David St. Germain served as the Chaska High School Speech and Debate Advisor from 1972 - 1992. Over those 20 consecutive years, each of David's teams advanced to the MSHSL Qualifier, and to the National Speech and Debate tournaments. During his time at Chaska High School, his teams earned a State Championship in 1980 - 1981, 2nd Place in 1979 and 3rd Place in 1976, 1977, 1983, and 1990. The National Speech & Debate Association also awarded David the National Diamond Coach Award for Coaching Excellence in 1982 & 1989.

**PAT SMITH, '09**  
**Outstanding Athlete**

Pat compiled a 177-31 record over 5 years on the varsity wrestling team at Chaska High School. He participated in five MSHSL Wrestling State tournaments, placing 3rd as a junior and 2nd as a senior. Considered the #11 rated national recruit in his weight class in 2009, he was awarded All-American honors once by the National High School Coaches Association and twice by USA Wrestling. Pat attended the University of Minnesota where he was a 4 year letter winner, 2x Academic All-Big Ten, 2x University National Champion (Greco-Roman), 4x University All American (2 Greco-Roman and 2 Freestyle). Pat continued his career internationally for Team USA, earning a spot on the National Team for the last 8 years. During that time, he represented the United States in 3 World Championships (2017, 2019, 2021), and was a member of the World Cup Team (2014). He collected over 15 international medals, including: 4 Pan-American Championship golds (2015, 2016, 2017, 2022), 1 Pan-American Games gold (2019), and a silver medal in the University World Championships (2014). In addition, he competed in 3 Olympic Trials (2012, 2016, 2020), including a runner up finish in 2016, and was a US Open Champion in 2017.
