



2023-2024 Tuition Memo

On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I want to thank you for sending your child to Saint John's Catholic Prep. We strive to be worthy of the trust that you have placed in us and to provide your children with the best possible education. We know that paying for private high school involves a significant sacrifice for parents, and we are so grateful to you for making a Saint John's Catholic Prep education possible for your child.

The Board of Trustees recently voted to approve a 3% increase for 2023-2024, bringing the tuition to \$18,675. This is an increase of \$545 for the year or \$54.50 per month on a 10-month payment plan. The comprehensive fee will increase to \$850 from \$700, and the Facility Fee will remain the same at \$250.

The decision to increase tuition is never taken lightly and is only made after careful consideration of the school's needs and priorities and the impact on our families. Given the significant rise in inflation, this increase is necessary to allow Saint John's to meet its many financial obligations. It also ensures we can continue to strengthen and grow our educational program, as well as remain competitive in attracting and retaining highly qualified faculty and staff.

The 2% discount incentive to pay in full by April 1, 2023 has increased to 2.5%, and we have reduced the payment plan administrative fee for the 10-month plan from \$300 to \$200. The re-enrollment deposit of \$400.00 will remain the same. Please note that deposits paid are applied to tuition.

If you are in need of tuition assistance from Saint John's and have not completed your FACTS Grant & Aid application, it is imperative that you do so as soon as possible. Financial Aid will not be awarded without a current, verified FACTS Grant & Aid application. All families who currently receive financial aid, or families who would like to apply for financial aid, must be current on their tuition account at the time financial aid is awarded. Financial aid will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis. Therefore, I encourage you to complete FACTS Grant & Aid and update it with your 2022 tax information as soon as you receive it.

Be on the lookout for an email from the Enrollment Office in the near future with information regarding re-enrollment. Do not hesitate to reach out to our Director of Enrollment Management, Mrs. Mary Catherine James, with any questions or concerns regarding the re-enrollment or financial aid process.
