Items of Discussion:

- Is Nibley on the list of potential school closures? There are several schools being consider for closure and the Board is looking at that this year. According to SLEA, no closures will occur until at least 2024-2025.
- We currently have 4 paras, not including EE, and it's been a struggle to find candidates not just for Nibley, but district wide. Requirements include: Must have HS diploma and at least 18 years old/ Could we possibly look into volunteers or hiring University of Utah students?
- Follow up on moving crosswalk farther east or having cones? People continue to park in non-parking areas/ Could we request some police presence during drop-off and pick-up?
- Willow presented the SHARP survey with a link to the previous data from 2019. 6th and 8th grade students will be taking this.
- March 19th – College and Career Readiness Day
- Went over TCI data- our benchmark is .4212/ Acadience- major focus is on K-3, is taken 3 x's a year. Currently, 62% in 1st and 2nd are on or above grade level, 3rd, 54% is on or above, and in K, 44% are below proficiency
- Many K-6 teachers are doing after-school tutoring
- We have many newcomer students this year (meaning they speak little to no English)/ our student body is 350, with 80 of those ELL students
- Elliot Helbling received the MLK Youth Leadership award
- Need more parents on SCC, some current members have not been showing up to meetings.
