Hart County School District is using and has plans to use ARP ESSERS funds for the following:

- 6 COVID Aid (1 per school, 2021-2022) to assist with Covid protocols such as assisting with temperature taking, additional cleaning, monitoring sick room, etc.
- 6 Acceleration Teachers (1 per school, both 2021-2022 AND 2022-2023 school years) to help address learning loss in each building; these teachers will provide interventions for students based on benchmark assessment and individual learning needs
- McGraw Hill Reveal Math (Grades K-10) curriculum and resources for Math
- McGraw Hill StudySync & Wonders (Grades 2-12) curriculum and resource for English
- TCI History Alive (Grades 4-8) curriculum and resources
- Professional Development - bringing in John Antonetti to our district to provide professional learning opportunities for teachers at all grade levels related to deeper learning and raising the rigor
- Purchasing math manipulatives (Grades K-5) to aid in their implementation of math curriculum
