



Dear Out of District Families,

Thank you for choosing the Bellevue Independent School District for your child's educational services. As the new superintendent, I can assure you that your child is surrounded by amazing teachers and staff who truly care about their academic, physical, and social-emotional needs. It is my sincere hope that you too are happy with the services your child receives while in our care and will continue to choose Bellevue Independent Schools.

Due to a new law (HB563) that was enacted last year, we have revised our out of district processes. The new process includes an out of district application that must be completed annually for each child. The application is attached to this letter and can be completed using technology or paper/pencil method. Completed forms need to be returned to Mrs. Katrina Rehtin, DPP, by Tuesday, February 28. Typed applications can be emailed to katrina.rehtin@bellevue.kyschools.us. Hard copies can be sent via mail to Katrina Rehtin 219 Center Street Bellevue, KY 41073, or dropped off at the Bellevue District Office or your child's school.

Our policy and procedures state nonresident pupils will be enrolled when they can be assigned to classes where the enrollment is below the allowable maximum and adequate resources are available. The district will consider attendance, behavior, and grades for enrollment. A student expelled from his/her previous school during the last school year will have his/her records and experiences reviewed before permission is granted for enrollment. When the number of nonresident students must be limited due to enrollment capacity, the following priorities will be observed:

- a) Those nonresident students attending school in this district last year will have priority over new applicants.
- b) Siblings of nonresident students already attending school in the district shall have priority over new applicants who do not have siblings currently enrolled.
- c) Students of district employees will have priority over new applicants.
- d) When priorities are equal, the date of application will be the determining factor for enrollment.

Please return your application as soon as possible. Notification of enrollment for the 23-24 school year will be given as approved, but all decisions will be made prior to the end of the current school year to give families adequate notice.
