



## **Senses of Scripture**

a s long as the people of God have been reading the scriptures, there have been different ways of reading and interpreting them—even reading the same verse in different ways.

Does that mean that scripture contradicts itself?

Or that it's not divinely inspired?

#### No, it definitely doesn't.

The way that we read it now is consistent with how the Bible has always been read, even in the earliest days of the Church. We read the Bible using the four different senses of Scripture.

We do use different terms today than some of the Church Fathers used to describe those different ways of reading the Bible. The terms we use today are from Thomas Aquinas (ST, I. Q1), but Aguinas relied on the writings of the Church Fathers to describe these different ways that we use to read the Bible. We're doing the same thing that the early Christians did when we read the Bible,

we're just using more precise terms.

This is what the Catechism means when it talks about the analogy of faith, and why that idea is important when we read the Bible:

Be attentive to the analogy of faith. By "analogy of faith" we mean the coherence of the truths of faith among themselves and within the whole plan of Revelation. (CCC 114)

When Catholics talk about different "senses" of Scripture, this is what we mean: the different ways that the writings in the Bible can be understood without contradiction.

That means that the Bible has to be read in the context that it was intended in order for us to understand the meaning of what is actually being said in the Bible.

There are two types of senses:

Literal

Spiritual

There is only one literal sense, but there are three spiritual senses.

The three spiritual senses are:

Allegorical

Moral

Eschatological



The three spiritual senses have to be rooted in the literal sense and can't contradict it, because otherwise the passage itself could mean whatever anyone wants it to mean. God is truth itself and He is the one who guides and inspires the human author to write, and those writings are intended to reveal who God is, and who we are to God. He's not trying to confuse us, but to lead us to Heaven.





The Philadelphia Flower Show at the Pennsylvania Convention Center is the world's oldest and largest indoor flower show. The 2023 Flower Show will once again welcome guests to experience the first taste of Spring indoors. In 2023, The Philadelphia Horticultural Society invites guests back to celebrate the spectacular and decadent floral displays that the award-winning Flower Show is known for, and to combine the radiance and joy that flowers provide. The show will reveal the exciting, energetic, and passionate side of flowers, gardens, and horticulture. Transportation is provided by a comfortable 36-passenger charter bus.

Lunch and dinner are on your own. The Reading Market, with its many wonderful food stalls and eateries, is just across the way, and your hand stamp will allow re-entry into the Convention Center. The trip fee includes admission to the show and transportation. Vienna residents pay \$98, everyone else pays \$122.50. If you have a WebTrac account, please use it to register. If not, then stop by the Vienna Community Center to do it in person.

I can tell you, after having attended this amazing show several times in the past, that it will be a long day with lots of time spent on your feet, walking, and standing as you view the displays, which are stunning. I can still recall the magnificent floral scent when I entered the Convention Center. Wear sturdy shoes, and take your

camera to capture the unique arrangements. In the past there were demon-strations and classes you could attend, which were interesting and also provided some respite. Bring a water bottle, and it'd be a good idea to include a heavy shopping bag as there's usually a great collection of gardenrelated items available for purchase. A small backpack would probably be a good idea too, and ladies, try to stick to a small handbag. For those of you who haven't ever attended this show, I highly recommend it! 
#### **ENCORE MOMENT**




