# Are You Interested In Being a CNA Fall 2024?

SHS partners with MATC to offer a CNA class. If you have any interest in taking the CNA course in the Fall semester of the 23-24 school year based on the description below please fill out the application linked **below** and return it to Ms. Schoemer (via email or physical copy) by **Wednesday, March 1st**. Completing the application does not mean you are locked into taking the course, however, students cannot take the course without it. Again, if you

The Nursing Assistant class is a great jump start to a career in health sciences and is a prerequisite for acceptance into most college level health science programs This hybrid course is taught by MATC staff and combines online instruction, on-site lab instruction, and community- based clinical experience. Students who complete the course successfully earn 3 college credits from MATC and are eligible to take the state certification exam (written and skill) and be listed on the Wisconsin Nurse Aide Registry.

# Start College Now/Early College Credit Program - Fall 2023

If you are an upperclassman who has exhausted courses in an area of interest and are looking for more opportunities, consider taking college courses through the Start College Now (through MATC) or Early College Credit Program (through a four year school). This program allows students to explore additional educational opportunities that the school district would pay for while earning college credit. Simply completing the application



does not guarantee that a course will be available or work within the school credit requirements but does open the door to the possibility. For the Fall of 2023, we need your applications by **Wednesday**. **March 1st** in order to be considered. Late applications will not be



# Upcoming Student Survey for Grades 5-12

SASD students in grades 5-12 will have the opportunity to participate in the School Perceptions Student Life Survey. The survey is designed to measure a student's engagement at school. It will provide our district with answers to important questions, such as:



- What practices and policies help our students learn, and what barriers are in the way?
- Do students feel supported?
- What could be done to increase student involvement, both in and out of the classroom?

Students will receive the survey by email and our staff will provide an opportunity for students to take the survey during the school day. The survey is online and takes approx. 10 minutes to complete. Once the survey is done, District and school leaders will receive a summary report that will provide valuable insight into areas of strength and the next steps for improvements in the quality of our students' experiences. The student survey window is from February 1 until February 15.

The survey is not a test, and students' grades will not be affected by their responses or participation. If you consent for your student to participate in this screening no action is

needed. If you do not consent, please contact your child's building principal no later than **January 25**.

### High School Pickup Guidelines

Reminder: Parents and taxis are not allowed to park in the bus loading zone, including lining up behind the buses.

When parents block this access for buses, this prevents all buses from entering and leaving the parking lot, and has made for a few near-contact situations as buses or vehicles try to leave.



Buses have a lot of blind spots, especially near the bus. Having smaller vehicles in the same vicinity of the buses during pickup is a safety hazard.

Do not pull in directly behind the buses in the front lot. Utilize visitor parking, or meet your student on Lincoln Street.

# Spring Athletics Registration Instructions

- 1. Login to the <u>Infinite Campus Parent Portal.</u>
- 2. Select "School Store" on the left hand side.
- 3. Select "Stoughton High School"
- 4. Select "Athletics."
- 5. Select the sport for which you are registering.
- 6. Under recipient, select the student who is registering for the sport from the drop down menu.
- 7. Scroll down to the list of Required Forms. Click on each form and enter the information needed in each fillable field.
- 8. At the very bottom of each form, there will be a spot to sign. Click on the red icon to complete your signature and then click on "Submit."
- 9. After all forms have been completed, add the sport to your cart.
- 10. Click on "My Cart," and checkout for \$0.00 by clicking "Submit." (There is no fee to complete the registration. Sport fees will be added to Infinite Campus after all sport seasons have begun and rosters have been formed.)
- 11. Your student will need to login to the <u>Infinite Campus Student Portal</u> to sign the forms as well they will appear on their home screen under "Documents."


