

CORPORAL PUNISHMENT

No teacher, administrator, student, or other person will subject a student to corporal punishment or condone the use of corporal punishment by any person under her or his supervision or control, except in self-defense or in urgent circumstances.

Physical restraint is authorized when deemed to be necessary in order to protect the safety of the individual student and/or other students and employees. Documentation of any incident requiring such restraint will be given to the principal.
