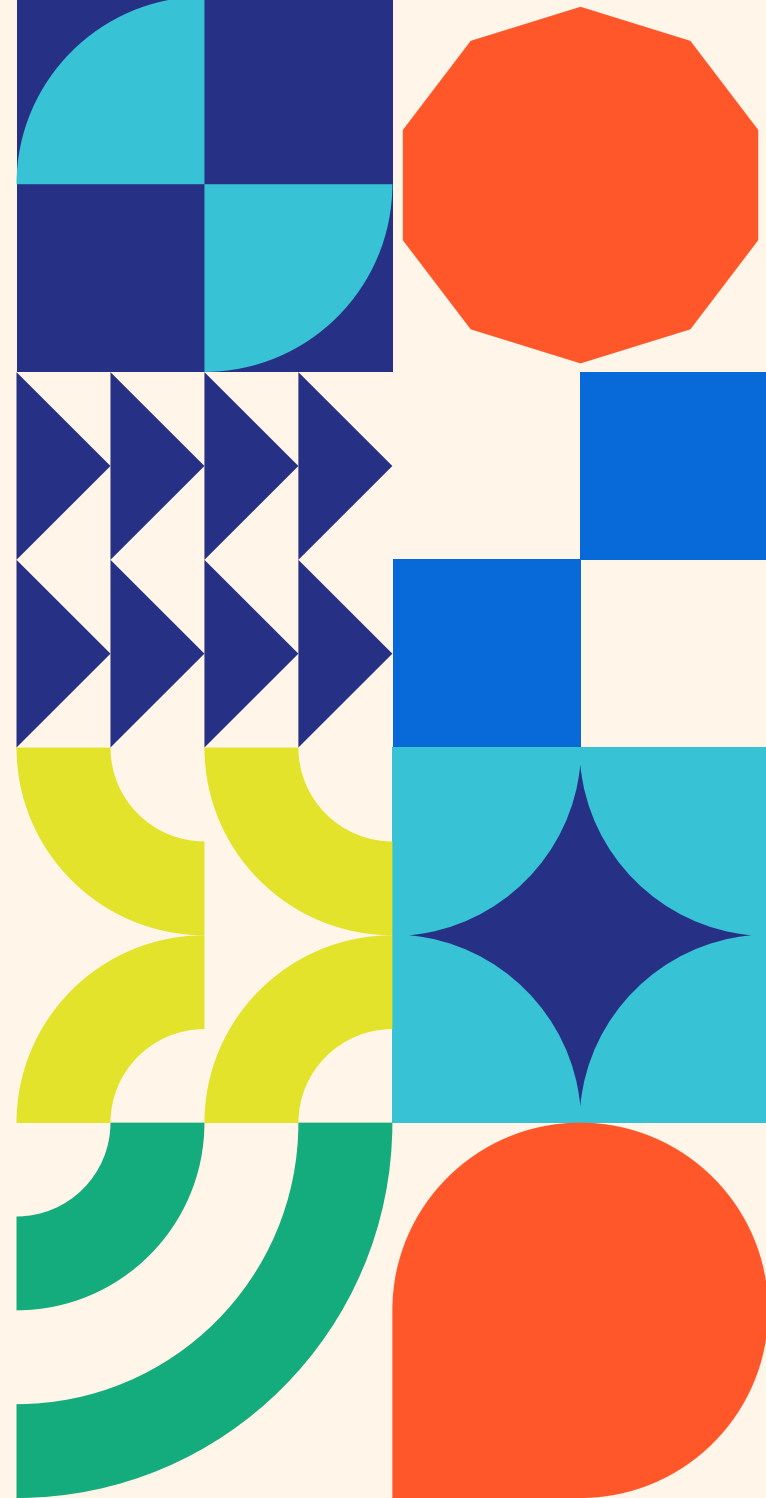

Message from Head of School

As we prepare for our 35th anniversary at KCS in September 2023, we wanted to share with you our Strategic Plan for the next three years. This will take us to our first graduating Class of Grade 12 in June 2025 and our next Canadian Accredited Independent Schools accreditation in November 2025.

KCS has always pushed boundaries, been courageous, embraced innovation, and defied the odds. Our story is a remarkable one. Our school started in 1989 as a result of the efforts of our Junior School Founders. We opened our doors to 50 students in Grades 1-5 in September 1989. Over the years, our school's population has grown to 398 students and once the Senior School is at full capacity in the next couple of years, we will have a total student population of approximately 660 students across both campuses.

We've watched our Junior School grow, year after year, enough for three facility additions and an amalgamation with St. George's Nursery School. Our Senior School will follow a similar path in growth as we add Grade 11 and 12 in September 2023 and September 2024 respectively, along with additional students in each grade. Independent elementary school education came to the west end of Toronto and Etobicoke in 1989. It was time for an independent KCS high school to follow. We look forward to the many students who will pass through our doors from the neighborhood, throughout the GTA, and around the world, as we move forward over the next three years.

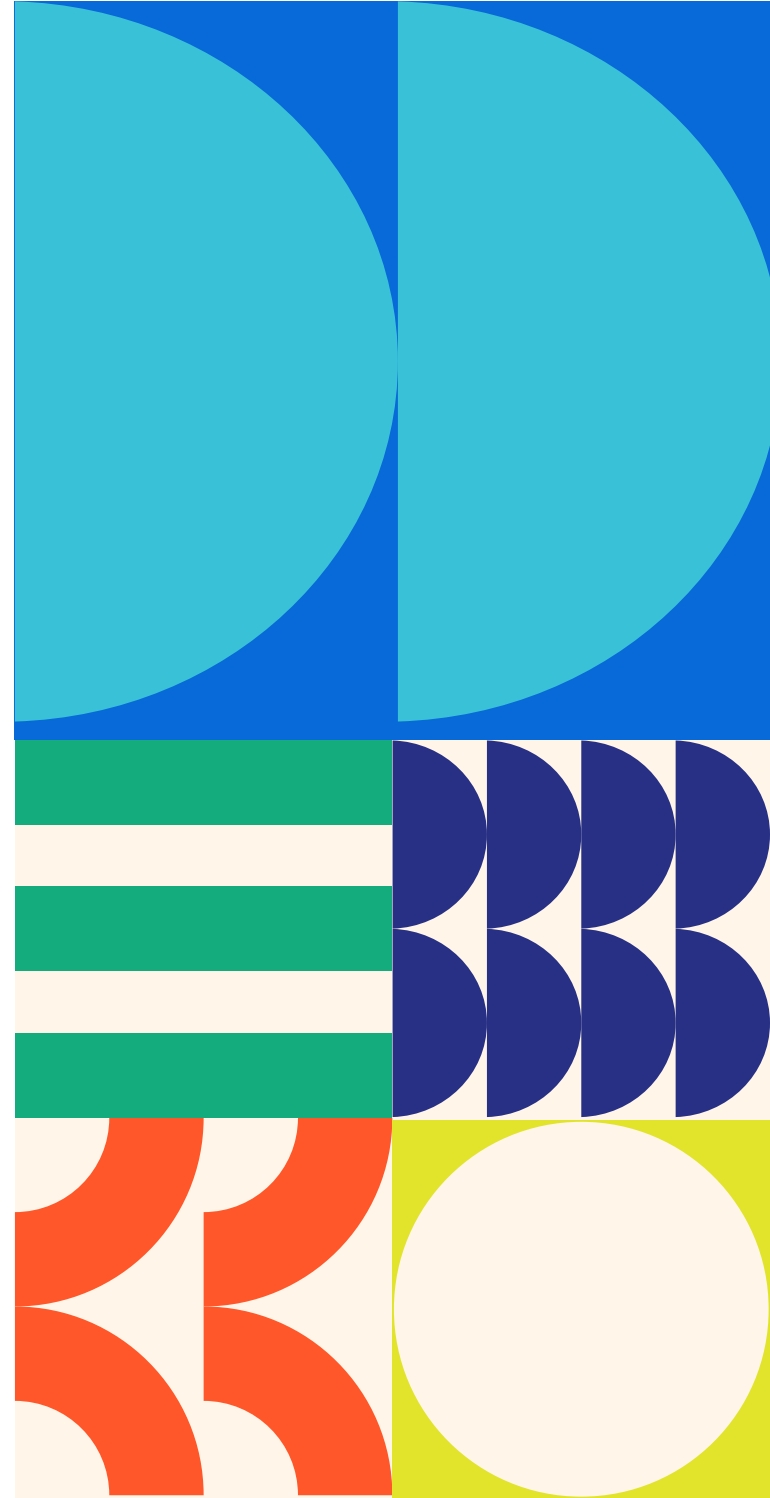
