### **M011000 Art Grade 6 (Required - 1 Semester)**

Students will build skills in Visual and Media Arts through the exploration of a variety of materials and techniques, such as drawing, painting, sculpture, graphic arts, animation, fibers, and photography. Art - Grade 6 builds visual literacy by engaging students in the meaning and use of images across cultures and times. Students have the opportunity to analyze why and how people make art and its connections to other areas of learning and human experiences.

### **M011300 Cartooning & Animation Grade 8 (Elective - Semester 1)**

Students will explore the worlds of animation, cartooning, and stop-motion animation using drawing, sculpture, object manipulation, and photography. Character development and storyline will pair with background and sound as students explore visual culture through a variety of Visual and Media Arts techniques.

### **M011400 Art Options Grade 8 (Elective - Semester 2)**

Using Visual and Media Arts concepts and tools, students apply critical and creative thinking skills, develop a sense of personal style, explore their ideas, and create and complete artworks for display. Students will explore techniques and develop skills in a variety of mediums, such as drawing, painting, photography, graphic design, animation, printmaking, fibers, and sculpture.
