

## WORLD LANGUAGES

### **M240001 and M240002 German Level 1 Grade 8**

#### **(Elective - Full Year)**

During the first level of language study, students acquire fundamental listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. The course presents elements of the cultures of the German world, prepares students for German 2. Topics are introduced which enable students to talk and write about themselves and their world. Reading, writing, and conversation will center on everyday life situations and will be enriched by the study of diverse German speaking world cultures.

*High school World Language Credit will be given upon successful course completion.*

### **M241301 and M241302 Spanish Level 1 Grade 8**

#### **(Elective - Full Year)**

During the first level of language study, students acquire fundamental listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. The course presents elements of the cultures of the Spanish speaking world, prepares students for Spanish 2. Topics are introduced that enable students to talk and write about themselves and their world. Reading, writing, and conversation will center on everyday life

situations and will be enriched by the study of diverse Spanish speaking world cultures.

*High school World Language Credit will be given upon successful course completion.*

### **M241501-M241502 Ojibwemowin Level 1 Grade 8**

#### **(Elective - Full Year)**

This course will provide students with opportunities to develop themselves as lifelong-learners of Ojibwemowin. Students will acquire fundamental listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in Ojibwemowin. Topics include, but are not limited to, grammar functions and vocabulary development, fluency with survival phrases, understanding through hearing and speaking the sounds of Ojibwemowin, and an applied understanding of elements of the cultures of the diverse Ojibwe-speaking world. Ojibwemowin language skills will center on everyday life situations and Ojibwe perspectives of oneself and the world. Required texts may provide a historical framework for contemporary life experiences.
