



MHS CLASS OF '64 SCHOLARSHIP 2023

Purpose: To provide a scholarship to one deserving Mainland High School senior who is planning to pursue further education after high school in either a vocational certificate program or college degree program.

1. **DEADLINE** for scholarship application is **Thursday, March 2, 2023 by 3:30p.m.**
2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements.
3. Refer to application process below for list of supporting documents required.
4. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered.
5. If you have questions about this application, please contact Mrs. Scheuerman, Student Service, in the Resource Room 1-257.
6. The MHS Class of '64 intends to provide one scholarship to one member of the MHS 2023 graduating class in the amount of \$1,00.
7. Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student's designated institution upon evidence of enrollment.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a member of the Mainland High School's senior class.
2. Applicant must have a minimum cumulative, weighted GPA of 3.0
3. Applicant must demonstrate a positive impact upon Mainland High School, as determined through letters of recommendation.
4. Applicant's financial need is a consideration.
5. Applicant must enroll in an accredited post-secondary institution in for 2023-2024.

Application Process:

1. Complete application form. If handwritten, **please print legibly.**
2. Official high school transcript (*current printed copy, not in sealed envelope*).
3. Personal essay (*Between 300-500 words*). In the essay, please answer the question: "What have you done to earn this award and what effect this award will have on your future."
4. Two (2) letters of recommendation from your choice of high school teachers or administrators.
5. Proof of acceptance to an accredited institution*
6. Submit completed application to Mrs. Scheuerman in the Resource Room 1-257.

***Acceptance Letter:** *Proof of acceptance to an institution for the upcoming school year is required. If an acceptance letter is not available at the time of application, proof of application should be included. If selected as the scholarship recipient, funds will not be released until proof of enrollment is provided and scholarship check will be payable to the enrolled institution.*
