Dear Herron Classical Schools Families,

I want to address a few timely issues that have been percolating in our city and state. Following up from my communication in December regarding the Indianapolis Public School's referendum-sharing plan, on Saturday, January 28, the IPS board had intended to hold a vote on moving forward with their operating referendum on the May ballot. Late on Friday, January 27th, IPS communicated a revised plan for sharing funds with Innovation Charter school leaders in hopes of garnering support in advance of their board meeting the following morning. While it appeared to move toward greater equity, many questions remained with no time to discuss them.

Also on Friday, the Indy Chamber released a statement opposing the operating referendum in its current form. The statement urged IPS and its Board of Commissioners to delay further action on their proposal until a plan can be developed that adequately addresses business and community concerns. Following the Chamber's statement, the operating referendum was pulled from the IPS Board of Commissioners retreat agenda. IPS continues to work on a viable plan that will garner public support on the November ballot.

Additionally, the critical issue of equal funding for charter schools is being addressed in this year's legislative session. On average statewide, there is a \$3,851 per student differential in funding for a traditional public school versus a public charter school. In the IPS district, where the largest number of public charter school students are located, the difference is approximately \$7,000 per student.

Currently, local property tax dollars pay for construction and maintenance of facilities, school building debt, utilities and student transportation for traditional public school districts only. For public charter schools like Herron Classical Schools, this facility funding must come out of the general operating funding. Families that pay local property taxes to support local schools deserve fair funding for their children, no matter if they choose a traditional public school or a public charter school.

We are so proud of Herron Classical Schools' history of academic excellence. We want to continue our ability to give our students an exemplary educational experience. This is why I am asking the Herron Classical community to show your support for equitable funding by signing the below petition created by Indiana Student Funding Alliance.

It's vital to let our state legislators know you support fair and equitable funding for all public school students in Indiana!

High School Counseling Information

It is time to begin considering course selections for the 2023-2024 school year. This is a very important process, as many things will be impacted by the choices your student makes. Course selection determines how well-prepared your student will be for the opportunities in and after high school. We ask students to consult their parents/guardians, teachers, and counselors in making these important choices. Your course selections impact the school's master schedule, so make sure your student is committed to their selections.

The specific Herron Classical Schools graduation requirements for the diploma options are listed at the link below. It is your student's responsibility to make sure they understand these requirements and earn the appropriate grades to achieve their desired diploma. Please be sure to ask your student's school counselor if you have questions regarding this information.

After making course selections, the counselors will meet with every student to review their requests, beginning January 23rd. As it is our intent to include the guardian in the student's course selections, final course selections will be distributed in late April/early May for the student's and guardian's final review and approval. If the student and guardian would like to make changes these must be communicated prior to May 19th.
