

Buffalo Valley Sportsmen and Beagle Club Scholarship

Scholarship: This year, Buffalo Valley Sportsmen and Beagle Club will have funds available to be awarded. The scholarship money shall be used toward defraying educational expenses such as tuition, books, etc. The scholarship shall be awarded for one year, however, may be renewed for additional years if a recipient continues to meet the conditions of eligibility. Renewal of a scholarship shall require the submission of a new application.

Eligibility: The scholarship recipient shall:

- Be a resident of Armstrong County
- A member of Buffalo Valley Club
- Can be a recipient outside of Armstrong County IF he/she is a child or a grandchild of a member of the Buffalo Valley Club
- A secondary school graduate with a commitment to attend a full accredited higher education program at a college or university
- A student who is presently enrolled in an accredited college or university which awards as a minimum, an associates degree
- Maintained a minimum of a 2.0 (C) grade point average during the previous 2 years

It is the responsibility of the recipient, through his/her application to establish eligibility as outlined in this paragraph.

How to Apply: Buffalo Valley is requesting from all applicants:

- Resume (needs include full name, home address, phone number, count of residence, high school, colleges/universities, hobbies, and/or any other applicable information of interest)
- Transcripts (grades for the immediate previous 2 years – high school, college/university)
- A double spaced, typed essay of 250-350 words
 - Theme: What is the importance of marsh and wetlands for wildlife?

The completed resume, transcripts, and essay MUST BE MAILED, so they are received no later than APRIL 1, 2023.
