Curriculum & Instruction Budget Highlights

- ❖ **\$214,000** - HMH “Into Literature” for grades 9-12 English, includes class sets and 5 year digital licenses
- ❖ **\$317,000** - Social Studies and History textbooks and 5 year digital licenses for grades 6–11
- ❖ **\$200,000** AR/VR technology for grades K – 12
- ❖ **\$75,000** - American Sign Language program materials (does not include staff)
- ❖ Classroom supplies for all courses, including EnVision Mathematics workbooks
- ❖ Replacement texts at all levels and additional texts due to shifting enrollments
- ❖ Presenters for Sayreville University and Staff Development Day
- ❖ Out-of-District Workshops and Conferences
- ❖ Ongoing, Sustained In-District Professional Development
- ❖ ESEA grants are the primary source of professional development funds and are supplemented by the local budget
