#### **EXTENDED INQUIRY PROGRAM**

Extended Inquiry (EI) is an optional extension of learning through independent study and creative research projects. Students must apply and demonstrate both interest and ability to take on and manage self-directed projects and learning. Extended Inquiry projects take place primarily outside of class time, and through independent research inquiry and investigations, though some projects may include collaborative discussions and meeting times as well. Each EI project includes critical reading, critical writing, research, synthesis of course content or across courses, a real-world connection, and a presentation for a panel of teachers. Freshmen are eligible for the Extended Inquiry designation in one course, sophomores are eligible for up to two. Juniors and seniors may propose transdisciplinary projects that earn Extended Inquiry in up to three courses in the 2022-2023 school year and two courses in the 2023-2024 school year (please note change in requirements that impact the Class of 2024).

# **CONSTELLATION LEARNING PROGRAM**

Hewitt is a member of Constellation Learning, a collective of independent schools coming together in a globalized, blended learning community. Hewitt's participation enriches our elective offerings and provides students primarily in grades 11 and 12 with the opportunity to learn in a collaborative, flexible, and alternative setting with other motivated students from around the country. Educators from other independent schools teach Constellation Learning courses, which are included on the Hewitt transcript.
