

Dual Enrollment

Dual enrollment is for high school students desiring to enroll at a community college.

- High school students may enroll in available courses if pre-requisite and requirements are met.
- Students may enroll in up to **11 units** during fall or spring semesters and **5 units** during the winter or summer sessions.
- Students are required to complete an online college application and submit a Dual Enrollment form in person.
- High school students are not required to pay for classes but must pay for books, enrollment fees, and parking (if applicable).

Most colleges require students to complete the following steps at minimum:

Step 1: Complete and Submit Online College Application

Step 2: Complete High School Dual Enrollment Form

Step 3: Meet with High School Counselor

Step 4: Submit **Dual Enrollment** Form to College with Counselor's Signature
