### **.Call to order**

#### **a. Show Debrief**

1. Smith talked about still needing to order the commemorative buckle. Hutchinson said that he would talk that on and then Mag West Officers would deliver it.

3. Live Auction brought in \$317,000

  - a. the only thing for sheep and goats is the hanging fans. In the rules it says the cords have to be off the ground. fans or no? hogs = no issues

    - i. committee decided that they are going to pay for those chickens.
  - d. Gomez, Capps, and Territo are good for doing Post Sale for next year.
  - e. Maybe use code for cash truck, so kids don't get confused when reading cash truck
- 20. Barn Clean Up
  - a. went well
  - b. had the kids that made the sale stay in the line and help out.
- 21. Thank you Cards
  - a. Want to add one more person to help out up there
  - b. do no pencils anywhere?
  - c. maybe erasable pens for the little ones? or let them use pencils?

**.New business**

- a. Steer Bids:
  - Our local steer supplier sold everything early because of no grass for cows. Need to find a few people who are going to call and get prices from. Try not to get American
  - Pay day is November 12th; Cost \$2,300
  - The guy we use we buy 5 - 10 and tell them to bring 3 extra just in case.
  - Need Summer born steers.
  - Need to be broke to tie
  - Want to get them around the 2nd or 3rd week of December.
  - Late Fee Sign Up???? in rule book that it is \$250, however there is no late sign up?
- a. Steer Entry and Steer Selection

- b. Look through the rules for next month as those will be revised
- c. MISD Livestock Committee Constitution – reminder to look through prior to next meeting for additional revisions
- d. Bring breeders and judges to next month's meeting
  - need lamb, goat and pig breeders for next meeting
  - we need full size non dwarf animals
  - Riley is asking a goat breeder Glen Martin about raising animals for selection.
    - sheep should be born february -march born; goat should be born jan-feb.
  - Smith said to relook at the contract possibly for breeders to make some changes?
- e. All of our Judges seemed well rounded
  - they all did well; talked to the kids; not too fast and not too slow
  - no complaints on judges
  - we do not really need to replace judges

Rules:

- a. baked goods
  - i. alcohol allowed as an ingredient
  - ii. cakes and pies should be cut ahead of time before being checked in
  - iii. need forks and plates for judge in the room
  - iv. can it be typed and printed or hand written legibly
  - v.

Hanging fans over pens needs to be reworded

- vi. Buyer bags who is responsible for filling them
  - 1. Riley took this on
- vii. Show Supply Truck
  - 1. Need it there next year not here this year.
  - 2. may have been because daughter was in the hospital
- viii. purchasing an MISD Ipad to livestream the show.
  - 1. Smith suggested to ask the Ben Pounce tech guy about help.
- ix. Talked about purchasing speakers for barn
- x. Having a paramedic on site Friday and Saturday about \$350 per day
- xi. Drug testing rabbits overnight; and keeping them on site
- xii. Having a type of information sign posted somewhere about how post sale works.
  - 1. Get a nice plastic board to then reuse year after year
- xiii. Parent asked "are other people allowed to handle or groom breeding animals?"
  - 1. we took it out years ago because we went with a blow and go.
- xiv. Heifers don't go into the food chain, so don't need to be drug tested

- xv. Contact buck sponsors prior to the show, so that they are present and there to represent. Need to be announced and told where picture is taken
- xvi. Overall heifer banner in addition to the buckle = no
- xvii. Permanent table cloth & back drop for auction block
- xviii. No animals will leave the night of the sale
- xix. Figure out a way for Chris Jones to write the number and figure out how to just move them into one pen. for magnolia support group
- xx. Rules will be next month
