As a follow-up to last week's amazing reading program, *Pep Rally for Reading*, Plymouth Center School will be kicking off "Superstar Readers", a winter reading incentive program that will last 3 weeks. Students will be working together to help their class gain the most minutes read.

Students will be encouraged to read at home and track the minutes they have read. Each week, the student with the most minutes read, per classroom, will receive a small prize and have their name announced over the school intercom. The maximum number of minutes that can be recorded is 90. If students tie for the highest minutes read, their name will be put in a drawing for the small weekly prize.

The classroom in each grade that reads the most minutes per week will receive a "Superstar Readers" book posted on their classroom door for all to see. The program will last 3 weeks and the class with the most reading minutes at the end of this time will win a popcorn/movie party.
