Concurrent Enrollment

Must have qualifying ACT score of 19-Composite & Subject Area

Dual Credit = High School & College Credit

- **English Comp. 1 & 2-** Students may enroll and must earn credit in college English Composition 1 & 2 to replace English 4
- **Government-** Students may enroll and must earn credit in college American Government to replace high school government requirement.
- **College Math -** Students may enroll and must earn credit in non-remedial college math course to replace needed high school math requirement.
- **Other course options** – Psychology, Speech, US History...

Concurrent Enrollment-continued

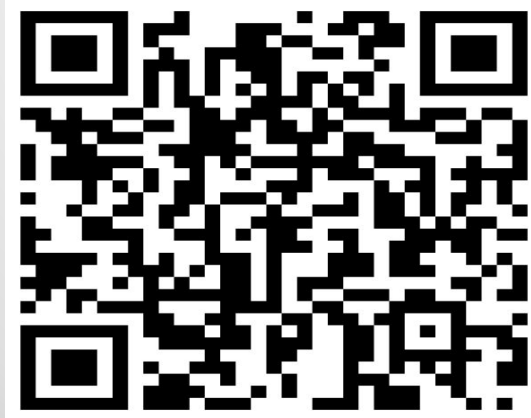
- ❖ Select your classes like you are NOT doing concurrent.
