ICAP

An ICAP (Individual Career Academic Plan) is a multi-year process that guides students as they explore career, academic and postsecondary opportunities.



Students must complete components of their ICAP each year of high school to meet graduation requirements.

Things to consider before enrollment:



You must meet specific course and gpa requirements! <u>Check with your</u> counselor to confirm requirements & courses.





Scholarship

Free tuition at any Oklahoma public two-year college or four-year university.

To Qualify:

- Household income must be \$60,000/year or less
- Students must meet the College Prep Graduation requirements.
- GPA Requirement 2.5 gpa for Core Classes & Overall.
- Students should work with their counselor to make sure needed courses are taken.
- Apply at <u>www.okpromise.org</u>

*Must apply by end of junior year!



- Canadian Valley will be at Mustang on February 7th- 9th for interviews with those students who have submitted applications.
 Makeup Day is Friday, Feb. 18th.
- Virtual students will interview at MHS on Feb 8th.
- If you have applied for CVTC, you will still need to fill out your entire enrollment form, as if you will be on Mustang's campus all day.

Concurrent Enrollment

- Opportunity to enroll in college courses and receive both college and high school credit
 - English Comp. 1 & 2- Students must earn credit in both college English
 Composition 1 & 2 to replace English 4
 - Government- Students must earn credit in college American Government to replace the high school government requirement.
 - College Math Students must earn credit in a non-remedial college math course to replace needed high school math requirement.
 - Elective course options Psychology, Sociology, Speech, US History...
- > Must meet enrollment requirements
 - ACT Composite score of 19 or 3.0 unweighted gpa or higher
 - ACT subject score of 19 in the subject area of the college course you want to take
 - Admission requirements vary depending on the college you want to attend

Concurrent Enrollment

What does it cost?

- The tuition is waived for up to 18 credit hours (6 courses)
- Students are responsible for paying the class fees plus the cost of books.
 - For example, Redlands Community College ESTIMATED Concurrent Fees:

 - three (3) credit hours = \$94 six (6) credit hours = \$163 nine (9) credit hours = \$232 twelve (12) credit hours = \$301
 - fifteen (15) credit hours = \$370
 - eighteen (18) credit hours = \$439
- Class fees are higher at 4 year universities like UCO, OU, and OSU.

Concurrent Enrollment Steps

- Request an official transcript by scanning the QR codes posted at the counseling office or through the MHS homepage.
- Request a signed Concurrent Approval Form from your counselor.
- Apply online to the college of your choice (OCCC, Redlands, OSU OKC, UCO, OU, etc.)
- Enroll in classes at the college of your choice.
- Give your counselor a copy of your concurrent course schedule.
- When enrolling for MHS, select 7 classes like you are <u>NOT</u> enrolling in concurrent courses.
 - MHS courses will be changed/updated once you have enrolled at the college & provided your counselor with a copy of your college class schedule.




