We are aware that there are some circumstances for which a student requires medication during the school hours. However, in compliance with Indiana statutes, medication cannot be given unless this form is signed by the legal guardian. The following guidelines must also be followed:

1. All medications must be transported to and from school by parent for students in grades 6-8. Students in grades 6-12 may transport medication only with prior authorization from nurse and parent signature.
2. Specific directions for medication administration must be in writing and signed by a parent. Directions must clearly specify the condition(s) for which the medication is to be administered, time to be given, the dosage, and any other related information.
3. All medications must be in the **ORIGINAL** container. Expiration dates must be current.
4. A record of all medication administered is kept by school nurse and parents are welcome to obtain a copy.
5. This form must accompany **EACH** medication brought to school. (additional forms available in the office or on school web-site)
6. Medication will be sent home at the end of each school year for students in grades 6-12. \*\*  
**Medication forms are applicable for the current school year only.** \*\*
