Typically, a “Year-to-Year Change” is shown





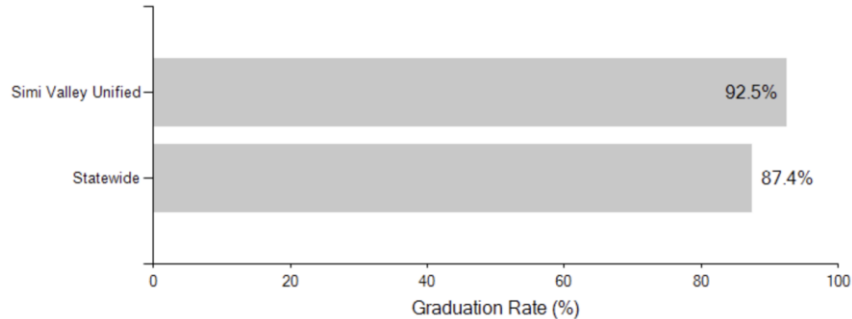
District Graduation Rate Compared to State



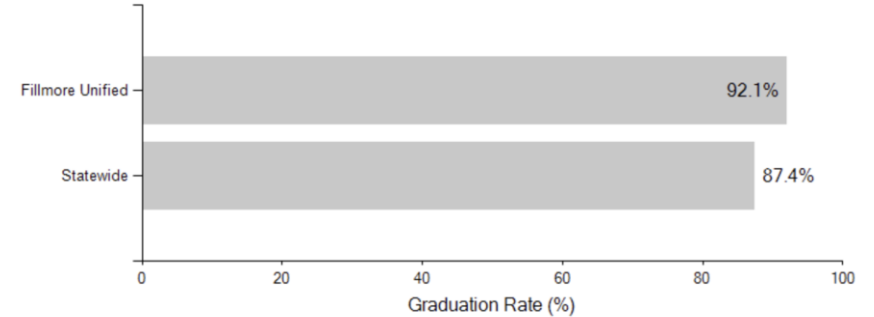

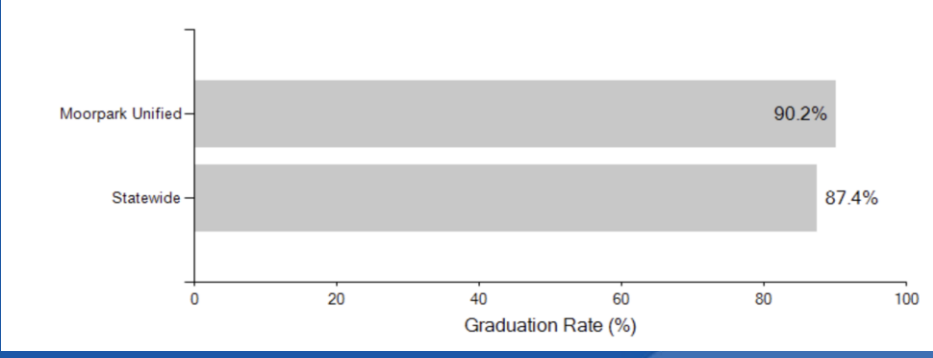
District Graduation Rate Compared to State



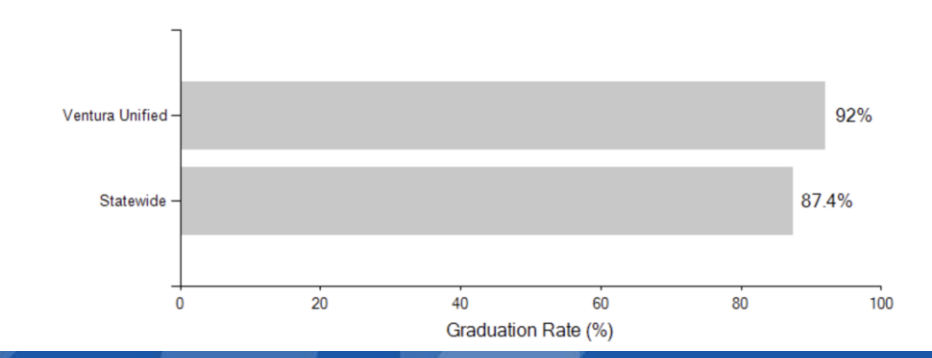

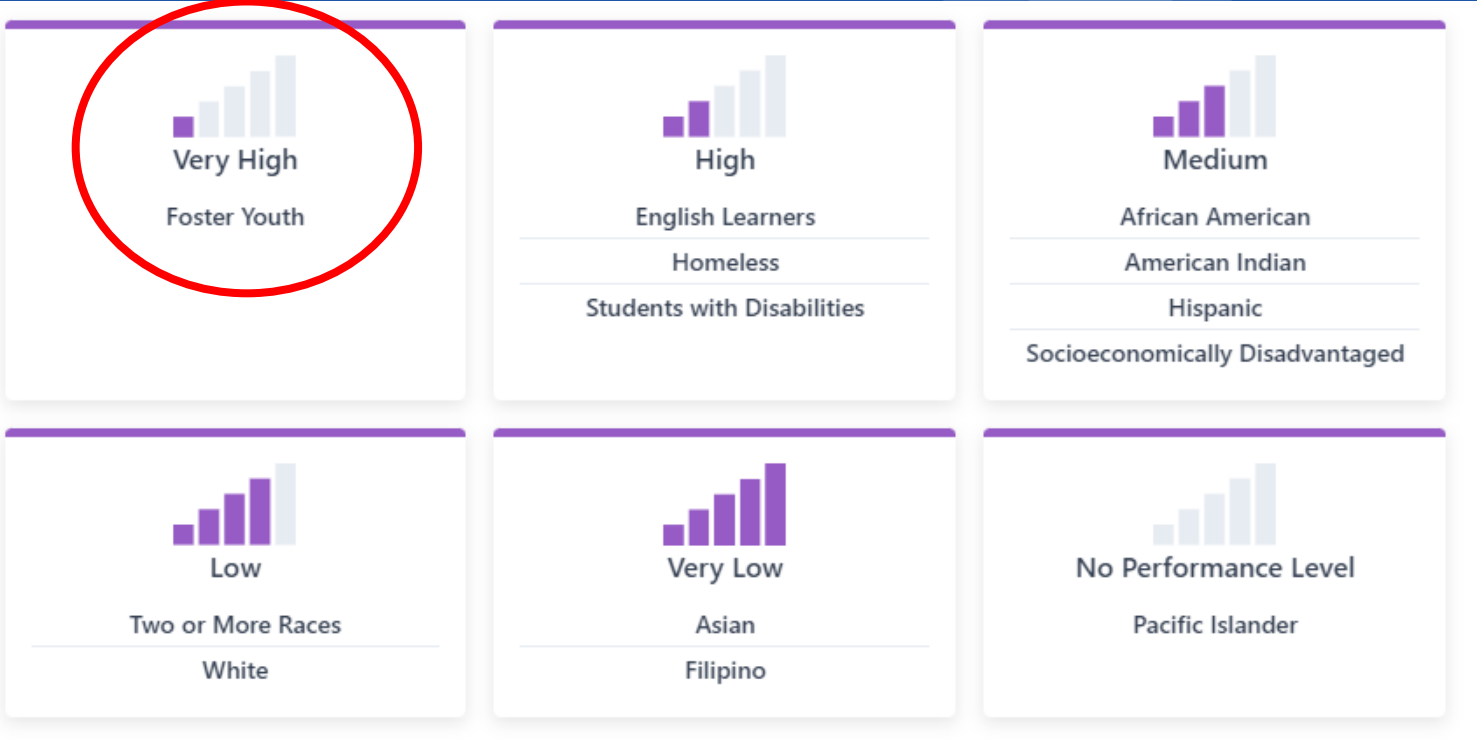

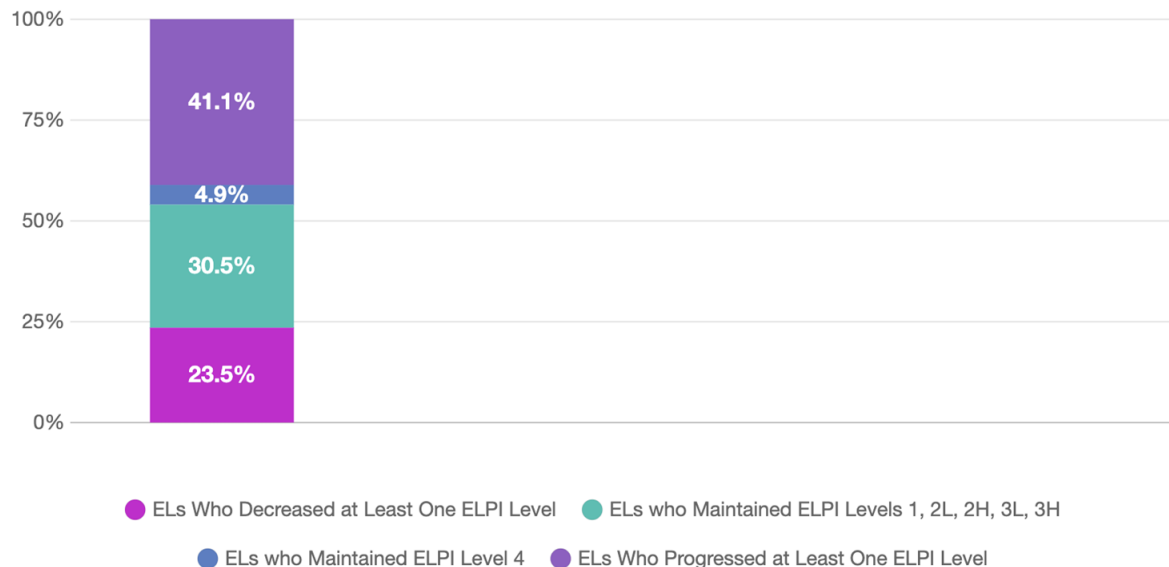
