



Piper PTA 203 has established 12 bank accounts dedicated to current grade levels Kindergarten-11th grade. Each account was established with a \$100 donation from Piper PTA.

The intent of the Class Accounts is to offset the financial burden of fundraising during Senior Year while creating an equitable approach for parents/guardians to contribute to their students' Graduating Class Graduation Party led by Project Grad.

Parents/Guardians will have two ways to donate to their students' Class Account. .

- Piper PTA will designate a “Donation Week”. parents/guardians will be able to send a check (made payable to Piper PTA) to school with their student. Checks will be collected and deposited in the designated Class Account.
- Before or After the “Donation Week”, parents/guardians will be able to donate to Class Accounts directly with Piper PTAs’ Financial Institute: Security Bank.
 - When donating directly with our Financial Institute: Please mention Piper PTA Graduating Class of 20XX. That will guarantee your funds go to the correct Class Account
 - These in kind donations are considered a Tax Deductible Donation and are nonrefundable. Please reference the IRS Charitable Contribution website for more information.

Piper PTA will communicate Class Account Balances quarterly as follows:

- Q1-30-Sept
- Q2-31-Dec
- Q3-31-Mar
- Q4-30-Jun

All Class Accounts will be included in our yearly Audit that is sent to Kansas and National PTA

Piper PTA will work directly with Project Grad for the applicable graduating class, to have funds donated. Once that account is closed a new account will be opened for that year's current Kindergarten class.

If you have already been collecting funds for your students’ Class please contact Piper PTA to get those funds secured.
