



## PROPOSED ACTION

<p>Summer@Brown Pre-College Program</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• This program is available to rising high school seniors</li><li>• Student must have achieved at least a 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale)</li><li>• The session runs for one week from July 13-17, 2020</li><li>• Guided visits to off-campus locations</li><li>• Application deadline: February 28, 2020</li><li>• Students may be responsible for an application fee and program deposit</li><li>• Students are supervised by Brown University personnel</li></ul>	<p>Summer@Brown offers more than 200 non-credit courses reflecting the wide range of Brown University's Open Curriculum, and puts students in contact with ways of thinking, seeing and doing that challenge them to reflect deeply and think critically about their work, their learning and their lives.</p> <p>Beyond the number and variety of courses offered, what's particular to Brown are the varying ways instructors put their courses together: some are straight ahead deep-dives in core areas of undergraduate study; others turn things sideways to get a different look; some focus on a very particular topic in order to gain an understanding of something very large; others are highly inter-disciplinary in their approach, drawing from multiple perspectives and methods of understanding.</p>
