Fordham University's Science and Technology Entry Program (STEP)

Fordham University's Science and Technology Entry Program (STEP) at Rose Hill is a rigorous pre-college academic enrichment program designed to prepare students in grades seven through twelve (7-12) for post-secondary school studies in science and mathematics and careers in STEM, health and licensed fields.

During the academic year, STEP offers an array of services and activities after school and on Saturday mornings. STEP also conducts a five-week, full-time summer academy. All classes take place at the Rose Hill campus in the Bronx and are taught by Fordham faculty, secondary school teachers and graduate students. STEP scholars benefit from camaraderie with the area's brightest students.

Programs and Support Services

- Enrichment Classes: Advanced work in mathematics, science, writing, and development of critical thinking and analytical abilities.
 - Academic, Career, Financial Aid and Personal Counseling
 - High School and College Selection Counseling
 - College Admission Exam (SAT) Preparation: KAPLAN Test Review conducts preparatory classes and provides course materials.
 - Career Activities: Guest speakers, field trips, career testing and conferences.
 - Special Lectures and Workshops: Introductions to specialized fields in the health professions, computer science, engineering, law and many more.
 - Educational Activities and field trips: Classroom academics are augmented by field trips, which include: visits to colleges/universities, museums, and research facilities.
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Eligibility

STEP is designed for New York State residents in grades 7 through 12 who are historically underrepresented minorities or are economically disadvantaged with an interest in pursuing careers in STEP targeted fields.

For the purpose of STEP, a student is considered a New York State resident if he or she resides in New York State and has lived in New York State for the last two terms of school prior to entry into the STEP program or resided in New York State for at least 12 months immediately preceding the first term for which he or she is seeking participation in the STEP program.

The State of New York has designated African Americans/Blacks, Hispanics/Latinos, American Indians or Alaska Natives as members of underrepresented groups. If an applicant does not meet this criterion, then he/she would have to qualify under economic guidelines set by New York State. A copy of the parent/guardian's Income Tax return will have to be submitted with the student's application. See website for economic eligibility chart:

- Resume detailing all extracurricular activities and other academic programs in which you are enrolled. Also highlight special awards received, AP courses, work experience, research/internship placements, and community service
- Supporting documentation if eligibility criteria are not met (income tax return)

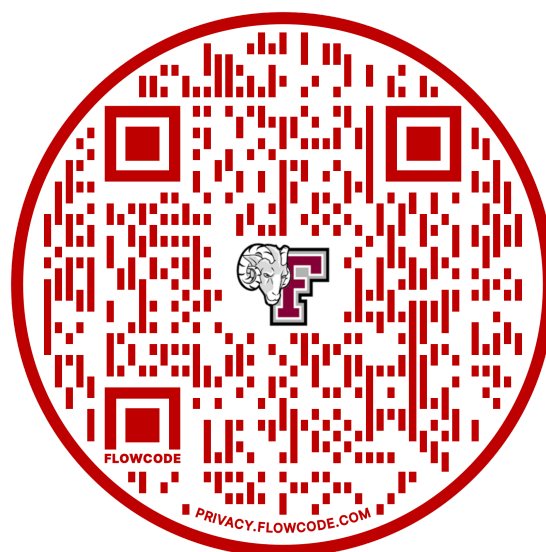

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Eligibility

Students in underrepresented groups, who are interested in scientific, technical, health and licensed professions are eligible to apply for entry into the program. The State of New York has designated Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native American, and Alaskan Native students as members of underrepresented groups.

Economically disadvantaged students are also eligible to apply for entry to the program. To meet the State of New York's established income requirements for STEP, the student's household income needs to be less than or equal to the income levels indicated below.
