Policy 640 – Title I Parent and Family Engagement

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Title I parent and family engagement policy is to encourage and facilitate involvement by parents and family members of students participating in Title I educational programs and experiences of students. The policy shall provide the framework for organized, systematic, ongoing, informed and timely parental involvement in relation to decisions about the Title I services within the school district. The involvement of parents and family members by the school district shall be directed toward both public or private school children whose parents are school district residents or whose children attend school within the boundaries of the school district and receive Title I services.

2.0 GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of the school district to fully comply with Section 1116 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, which requires the school district to develop jointly with, agree upon with, and distribute to, parents and family members of children participating in Title I programs written parent and family engagement policies.

3.0 DEVELOPMENT OF DISTRICT LEVEL POLICY

The school board will direct the administration to develop jointly with, agree upon with, and distribute to, parents and family members of participating children a written parent and family engagement policy that will be incorporated into the school district's Title I plan.

4.0 DEVELOPMENT OF SCHOOL LEVEL POLICY

The school board will direct the administration of each school to develop jointly with, agree upon with, and distribute to, parents and family members of participating children a written parent and family engagement policy that will be incorporated into the school's Title I plan.
