

Curriculum Development Phases

1 PHASE ONE

Assemble a content area Curriculum Design Team made up of teachers and administrators to review district data, best instructional practices, state & national standards, district goals, and content area needs.

RESEARCH

YEAR 1

2 PHASE TWO

Review and analyze resources that match district needs. If necessary, conduct a pilot student. Seek approvals.

RESOURCES

YEAR 1

3 PHASE THREE

Develop curriculum outlines for each new or revised unit of student with essential questions, standards alignment pacing guides, and assessments. Provide necessary professional learning.

MAPPING

YEARS 1 & 2

4 PHASE FOUR

Implement new units of study. Review assessment data. Based on data, adjust unit maps, assessments, or instructional strategies as needed. Provide professional learning and ongoing teacher support as needed.
