- Can be easily integrated with our current Voice-over-Internet-Protocol (VoIP)
- Control access using the reader, keypad, or the integrated camera and achieve a greater level of security for all those on the location.

Redesigned Phrase II: New office entrance

- Workroom currently located in the southeast corner of the office building will be transformed into a receptionist area with desk.
- Current windows may be converted into double-entry doors
- A gate will be installed between new doors and existing doors
- Creating a single-entry point during school hours

Redesigned Phrase II

Bike Rack Area/Fencing

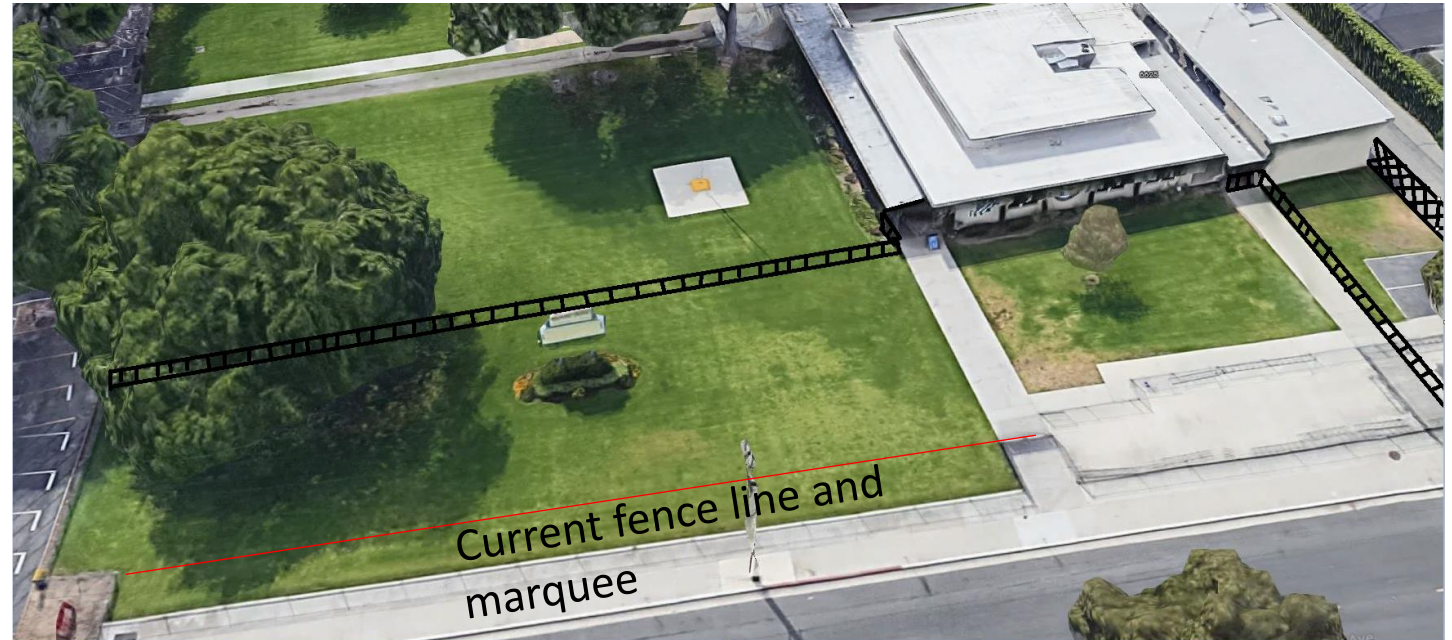
This scope of work includes replacing the existing grass area near the 500 building with asphalt to create a new bike rack area. Chain link in lieu of wrought iron to surround the bike rack area.

Hallway Gate (500 Building)

Install the gates at the beginning of the 500-building hallway to secure the campus. The material use will be for wrought iron and mesh angels and gates.

Front Fence

The existing front fence can be reused and moved in-house. When we moved the fence to accommodate the marquee, new posts will be required.

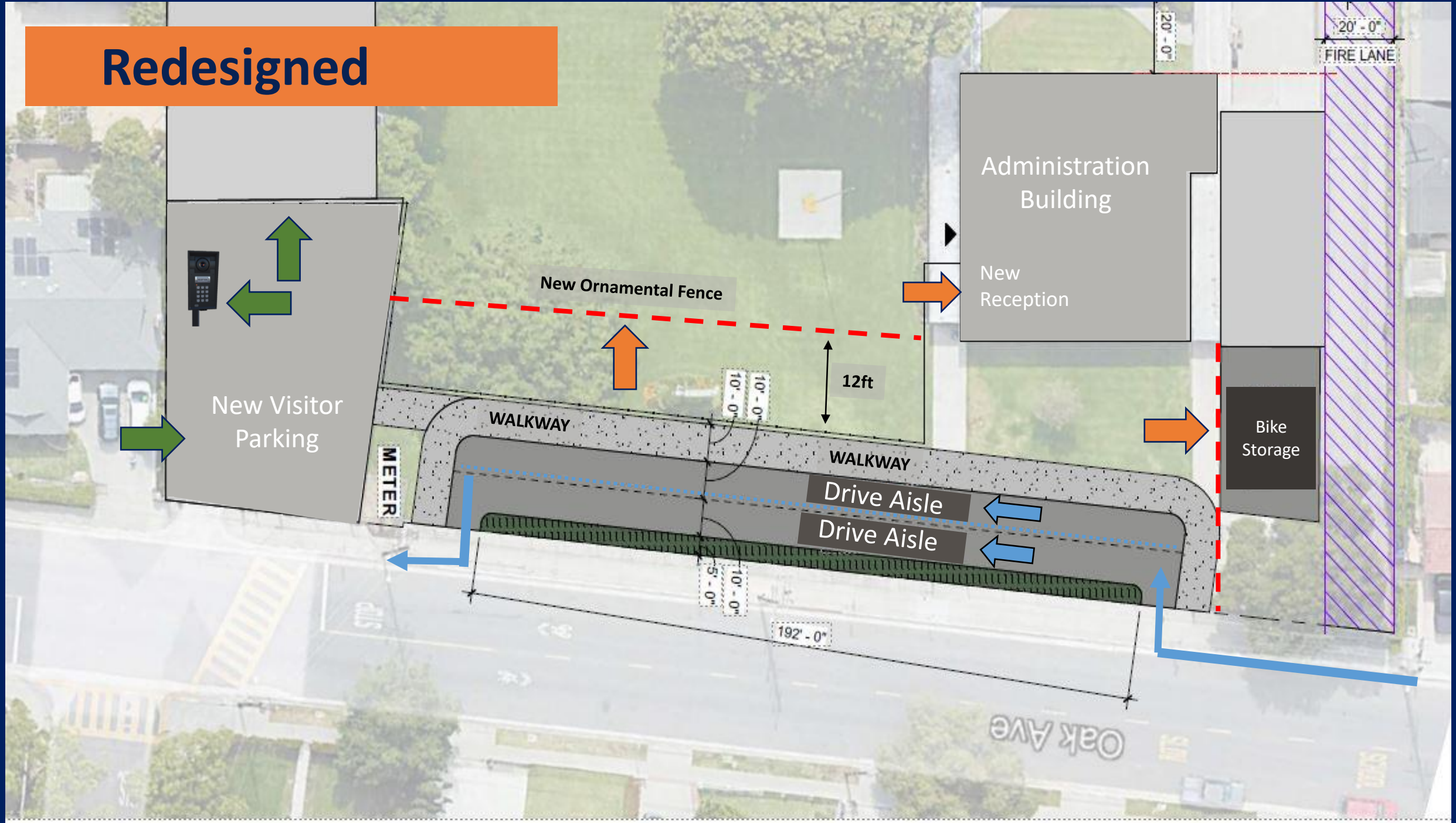
